## **MINUTES OF THE WEBEX INTEGRATED QUALITY IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE (IQuIC) MEETING**

April 27, 2021 10:00 am to 12:00 pm

### **1. Call to Order**

The Contractor shall have its Quality Improvement Director participate in the Department's Quality Improvement Committee to provide input and feedback regarding quality improvement priorities, performance improvement topics, measurements and specifics of reporting formats and timeframes, and other.

### **4. Rapid-Cycle PIPs Module 3-specific Training**

Kris opened this discussion by noting past Performance Improvement Project (PIP) module efforts, options for future technical assistance (TA) calls and the purpose of today's presentation. Prior to today's presentation Chris shared a Plan-DO-Study-Act (PDSA) worksheet and module 3 submission form. Today's presentation included a PowerPoint presentation that discussed module 3 intervention testing, a submission form walk-through, validation guidance, programmatic significance, and a PDSA worksheet walk through. After the presentation Heather Steele (Rocky Mountain Health Plan) asked Kris if each time when an intervention is submitted it should be submitted to Health Services Advisory Group (HSAG) for approval? Kris agreed. Katie Shrawder (DentaQuest) asked Kris to confirm the number of forms for the module 3 submission? Kris confirmed there are three (submission, validation tool, PDSA worksheet). Katie then asked if a problematic, or clinical response can be used for the intervention effectiveness measures? Kris said either can be used and Christy (HSAG) elaborated on the two options.

Jerry noted that the Department's website updates are completed and reminded health plans to review the health plan Progress Report handout to get an update on current quality projects. Russell (HCPF) informed health plans working on CAHPS surveys that their respondent level data will be available a bit sooner than normal and that he is following up on this option.
