

Dear Dental Service Provider,

The Occupational Health & Industrial Hygiene Unit in the Health Equity Branch at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) has initiated a pilot program to assess and improve indoor air quality and ventilation at facilities and workplaces throughout Colorado. This program serves to reduce disease risk, and improve overall health outcomes, related to common indoor air pollutants and respiratory pathogens like SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. This program is funded through the National Initiative to Reduce COVID-19 Health Disparities Among Populations at High-Risk and Underserved (OT 21-2103) by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Facilities interested in participating need to fill out the Interest Form for the Indoor Air Quality and Ventilation Assessment and Improvement Program in either English or Spanish. There will be a follow-up to collect more information, determine eligibility and answer any questions about participating in the program.
