



## **MINUTES OF THE INTEGRATED QUALITY IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING**

March 26, 2024, 10:00 am to 12:00 pm

### **1. Call to Order**

The Contractor shall have its Quality Improvement Director participate in the Department's Quality Improvement Committee to provide input and feedback regarding quality improvement priorities, performance improvement topics, measurements and specifics of reporting formats and timeframes, and other.

### **2. Review February 2024 Draft Minutes**

Jerry (Health Care Policy and Financing/HCPF) and meeting attendees reviewed the draft minutes, and the minutes were approved.

### **3. Network Adequacy Data Initial Validation (NADIV) Dashboard Future Session Update**

Jerry (Health Care Policy and Financing/HCPF) opened up this brief topic by noting some Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requirements related to network adequacy, and the Department and Health Service Advisory Group (HSAG) developed tools to help meet those requirements. Jerry noted that HSAG will be scheduling a non-mandatory refresher call sometime in July 2024 or August 2024 to review the NADIV tool. This refresher call is being set up to further assist health plan network adequacy staff with their efforts to meet the CMS requirements.

### **4. Managed Care Entity (MCE) Health Equity Report Submissions Update**

Aaron Green (Health Care Policy and Financing/HCPF) opened the topic up by noting his internal team has completed reviews of the health plan submission made to the Department. Aaron also said that internal Department staff are having discussions to further understand partnerships for this effort. Aaron then spoke on past activities involved with this effort (example: over 20 town halls, statewide task force, other) and 5 work groups to help understand access to care. Aaron noted that the Department has received a number of recommendations related to this effort and

that responses to those recommendations are in the works. Aaron shared insight about the Health Equity Report goal and the trend and collective work data that will be included in that report. The following Department of Public Health & Environment link was shared with meeting attendees to assist them with health disparities and social determinants of health impacts
