

The purpose of this change form is to highlight revisions to the State Behavioral Health Services (SBHS) Billing Manual. Unless otherwise noted, the State (HCPF and BHA) has agreed that it will accept coding provided under the previous edition through December 31, 2024. Providers must implement the January edition by December 31, 2024, for dates of service January 1, 2025, and thereafter, regardless of submission date.
