## Pediatric Long-Term Home Health (PLTHH) Prior **Authorization** Request (PAR) Restart

The PAR process allows HCPF to demonstrate a statewide surveillance and utilization review process that meets federal regulations. All PLTHH services will begin phasing in a PAR requirement in the Spring of 2025. This process will be separate from the case management PAR process.



# PLTHH PAR Updates and Looking Forward:

#### PAR Timeline - Looking Back:

- PLTHH PARs were paused: July 1, 2020
- Phased-in approach to resuming PLTHH PARs began: November 1, 2021
- PLTHH PARs paused again: February 28, 2022 Present

#### **New PAR Restart Work Updates:**

- Soft Launch PT, OT, ST PARs starting February 3, 2025
- Go-Live PT, OT, ST PARs no sooner than May 1, 2025 (dependent on MOE)
- Go-Live RN and CNA PARs July 1, 2025
- SEE Operational Memo (OM) 24-060

The Nurse Assessor is a process to streamline the way members are assessed and receive a recommendation for skilled care services. The nurse assessor will utilize the newly developed valid and reliable acuity tool to reduce duplicative service authorizations and remove a conflict of interest on behalf of providers, while providing member education on all available skilled care service options.




## Updates and Looking Forward: Nurse Assessor

- Work started on this initiative Summer 2024
- HCPF has posted a request for proposal (RFP) to solicit vendor interest in conducting this work on behalf of HCPF
  - Limited stakeholder engagement can occur during the RFP process
- HCPF anticipates phasing in the nurse assessor with the resumption of pediatric LTHH PAR requirements
- The nurse assessor will use the newly developed Skilled Care Acuity Assessment to determine level and hours needed of skilled care for both pediatric and adult members
