## 2023 By the Numbers

- 79 bills tracked this year (683 introduced)
  - ☐ 8 Agenda Bills
  - ☐ 3 High Priority Bills
  - 27 bills that we monitored closely
  - 41 additional bills that are relevant to HCPF
- 76 bills assessed for fiscal impact, plus 18 amendments = 94!
- 1100 Final Votes 959 YES Votes 88%!!!
- 20+ HCPFers testified or provided technical assistance on at least 19 bills

- All of our budget requests were approved with only a few small changes by the JBC - <u>SB 23-214</u> The Long Bill.
- Highlights included:
  - Rate increases for providers, in many cases above and beyond our request
  - Expansions of services, such as doula services, donor milk, and expanded respite care for children
  - Administrative resources to support many priority initiatives, such as PHE unwind, BHA claims integration, DOJ response, and many others
