



## Managed Care Accreditation

Per 42 CFR 438.332, the State is required to post the accreditation status for each contracted Medicaid Managed Care Entities (MCEs). If an MCE is accredited by a private independent accrediting entity, the State is required to post certain information regarding the accreditation. The Department of Health Care Policy and Financing does not require its MCE's to be accredited.
