Attendee:	How is the designation of Comprehensive Safety Net Provider decided?
Ashlie Brown (CHI):	Summary of answer: The BHA is currently working to determine this designation. In general, Comprehensive Safety Net Providers provide higher levels of high-quality care.
Attendee:	Is the universal contracting and single entity to process credentialing only for behavioral health providers or all providers?
Kendra Neumann (CHI):	Summary of Live Response: Right now, this is only for behavioral health. Right now, the RAEs are really managing the behavioral health capitation side, so that's the current focus.
Suman Mathur (she/her) - CHI:	Thanks for these questions - as a reminder, if you do have access to the Q&A feature, please share your questions there.
Attendee:	How are the levels of care determined?
Ashlie Brown (CHI):	Summary of Live Response: HCPF is working to develop clearer expectations and guidelines for the levels of care. There will be additional opportunities to engage on this question announced soon.
Attendee:	How does home health or private duty nursing fit into this proposal?
Kendra Neumann (CHI):	Summary of Live Response: For those receiving both physical and behavioral health services, this is where the high fidelity wraparound and intensive care coordination proposals will plug in. We are thinking through how to support children and youth who have these needs. At the same time, we want to ensure there is coordination between the ACC, the Office of Community Living, and providers.
Attendee:	How will screening in primary care settings be represented in this proposal?
Ashlie Brown (CHI):	Summary of live answer: Primary care providers and settings are vital to screening efforts. HCPF will continue to work to encourage screening in this settings. Work has been done pursuant to SB19-195 to identify appropriate screeners and establish best practices. HCPF expects primary care settings to continue to be a key point of screening for all Health First Colorado members.
Attendee:	Is there a list of Quality Measures for the MCP model that you will be referencing when designing Phase III?

Ashlie Brown (CHI):	The Proposed Incentive Measures are listed here on slide 30. We will re-up the pdf of these slides for reference.
Ashlie Brown (CHI):	Replying to "How will screening i..."
Attendee:	I'll take that question about APMs for individual PCMP back to our membership, it's a good one and we will include some suggestions in written comments.
Suman Mathur (she/her) - CHI:	Wonderful, thanks.
Attendee:	Please take a close look at how many measures are available for peds/adolescents to ensure pediatric practices have similar or the same number of options as adult practices. Additionally, using standardized measures and basing performance on claims emphasizes how important it is to improve attribution accuracy.
