## Minutes:

- We will be having tri-chairs with Kelly Causey representing BHA, Jamie Ulrich, and Robert Werthwein
- Jamie U., call out to committee members to please send agenda items for the next meetings to Kelly at Kelly.Aaronson@state.co.us.
- Motion to approve May Meeting minutes with Becky W., second motion John K.
- Stacey D. provided Implementation Plan update and renaming work/website/meetings to Colorado System of Care (CO-SOC) instead of M-SOC. No opposition.
- Stacey D. provided July 1, Cohort 1 update. The bulk of the work from July-October 2025 will be readiness activities with the RAEs.
  - Some RAEs who have providers ready and willing to go will implement "test-runs" and the actual soft-launch of CO-SOC will be Oct. 1, 2025.
- HCPF will be hosting three Potential Provider Forums across July-September to discuss the philosophy of CO-SOC, the NWIC Model, HFW, and next steps. Priority around connecting them to the Workforce Capacity Center.
- Jamie U. posed the idea to build a provider network with RAEs to discuss provider gaps, avoid oversaturating certain areas, and how to prioritize dollars.
- Jamie U. requested that we bring information regarding "readiness" to the next meeting, including where gaps are occurring and levels of accountability.
- Meg T. and Amanda B. provided updates within their RAEs and how they are gathering information from providers, and what they are currently working towards.
- Jamie U. reviewed the HFW county proposal, reported it was approved by the Statewide Leadership Committee last week.
- Stacey D. reviewed the ESA, CANS, and CANS Decision Support Matrix materials and the one-pager summarizing each material.
- Time did not allow for Implementation Plan and Appendix J discussion.
