Keystone Peer Review Organization (Kepro) will be the new utilization management (UM) partner for Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) as previously announced in the <u>February 2021 Provider Bulletin (B2100459</u>). Kepro is replacing eQHealth Solutions, Inc. and will begin to receive Prior Authorization Requests (PARs) no earlier than May 1, 2021. Kepro will also be responsible for the prior authorization of select Physician Administered Drugs (PAD).
