- c. GPS and Matt Reidy (PCG) shared a plan for upcoming meetings, a progress update, and upcoming workgroup deliberations
 - i. Discussion:
 - 1. JB: Changes to HCPF's contracts with MCOs will likely require CMS approval and potential rate setting work. Could these actions happen after the preprint is approved? Is there anything in the practical timeline that we should be concerned about that will delay our ability to get money out the door?
 - a. MR: Will need to get back to you on sequence of events. In terms of getting money out the door, it's likely the CMS review period will be measured in months.
 - b. JB: Request a separate discussion to understand the full path and upcoming logistics, requirements, etc. and who will need to be involved downstream.
 - c. SL: The preprint does not require that actuarial rate certification be completed, but the document



- must contain the date for when the certification will be complete.
- 2. AS: When CMS has questions about the preprint, will the workgroup be needed to help answer those or will the HCPF team handle that?
 - a. ND: Questions like this would typically be handled through the administrative team at HCPF and with the CHASE Board. It's possible that the CHASE Board may want the workgroup's input on specific topics.
- 3. Jason: Assuming the pre-print is not approved until after July, how does HCPF plan to handle current UPL payments for SFY2026?
 - a. ND: FY 24-25 payments will be effective through September 2025 (FFY). Beyond, we would be on an interim basis and maintain same fee and payment until we have CMS approval. At that time, there will be a sizable reconciliation.

2. CHASE Board Update (~12:20 PM)

- a. Nancy Dolson (HCPF) shared an update based on the April 22, 2025 CHASE Board meeting, including feedback, questions, and guidance on workgroup's efforts and timeline. The CHASE Board recommends the workgroup continue efforts as soon as reasonable and preserve a July 1 effective date for the SDP Preprint submission. Next Board update will be May 13.
 - i. Discussion:
 - 1. AS: Based on what we learned from the CHASE Board, does that solidify that we should keep late May and early June open for additional meetings to try and meet the timeline?
 - a. ND: Impression from the CHASE Board is not necessarily that the workgroup add meetings, unless it makes sense for the specific questions and topics at hand.
 - b. ND: If we can gain consensus on ACR and quality metrics on May 7, as is planned, we will be well on our way by mid-June.



2. CHASE Model Update (~12:30 PM)

- a. Nancy Dolson (HCPF) shared an update on the draft FY 2024-25 CHASE model, implications, and resources to learn more.  - i. Discussion:
 - 1. AS: Important to be able to continue covering expansion populations and also recognize the challenges. Want to highlight the priority and how important it is to preserve coverage.

3. ACR Update (Continued) (~12:40 PM)

a. Scott Humpert (PCG) provided an update on the ACR calculation, status, and plan. The subgroup has been meeting (and will continue to meet) to discuss data sources and methodologies. The goal is to determine an ACR that is reasonable and most appropriate for this SDP and that is also demonstrable to CMS. Will present more information to the workgroup during the May 7 meeting.
