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





Older Adult Policy Strategy

Medicaid Programs Shorter-Term Plans

- Improve access and case management.
- Roll-out new assessment tool and support planning process.
- Implement sustainability plan for Colorado Choice Transitions (CCT), Colorado's Money Follows the Person.
- Better understand how people are using the PACE Program.
- Improve transitions from hospitals.

Turbo Charge the Work

- Hire Older Adult Policy Advisor to focus on all services and programs for older adults.
- Develop **Strategic Roadmap** for Colorado Medicaid older adult policies.
- Work with contractor to host stakeholder strategy sessions to develop Strategic Roadmap.

Emerging Promising Strategies

- Consider social determinants of health.
- Invest in better end of life planning.
- Require a comprehensive evaluation of medications.
- Leverage the older adult workforce and better support the healthcare workforce.
- Support family caregivers with opportunities for respite.
- Use technology to improve care.
- Utilize existing funding to support the whole individual.
