



### Goals

- 1. Identify best option for credentialing behavioral health providers for ACC Phase 3.
- 1. Reduce administrative burden for providers.

## Option 1: Credential via CAQH

#### Pros

- Compliant with federal regulation
- Providers already using CAQH tool
- Most cost-effective centralized credentialing option for the Department

## Option 2: Credential in-house at HCPF

#### Pros

- Compliant with federal regulation
- Could streamline credentialing and enrollment processes

#### Cons

- Resource intensive for the Department
- Would require a significant implementation timeline



# Option 3: Credential via a single RAE

#### Pros

- Compliant with federal regulation
- Less resource intensive than in-house option

#### Cons

- Provider experience: may require additional system access for providers, in addition to system access required for contracting with RAE(s)
- More resource intensive than credentialing directly with



## Option 4: Status quo

#### Pros:

Compliant with federal credentialing requirements

#### Cons:

Administratively burdensome for providers

## Recommendation: Option 1 - Credential via CAQH

- Lightest start-up lift
- Most cost-effective centralized credentialing option
