# *Options for Centralized Credentialing*

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# Goals

1. Identify best option for credentialing behavioral health providers for ACC Phase 3.
1. Reduce administrative burden for providers.

# *Option 1: Credential via CAQH*

## Pros

- Compliant with federal regulation
- Providers already using CAQH tool
- Most cost-effective centralized credentialing option for the Department

# *Option 2: Credential in-house at HCPF*

## Pros

- Compliant with federal regulation
- Could streamline credentialing and enrollment processes

## Cons

- Resource intensive for the Department
- Would require a significant implementation timeline

# *Option 3: Credential via a single RAE*

## Pros

- Compliant with federal regulation
- Less resource intensive than in-house option

## Cons

- Provider experience: may require additional system access for providers, in addition to system access required for contracting with RAE(s)
- More resource intensive than credentialing directly with

# *Option 4: Status quo*

## Pros:

- Compliant with federal credentialing requirements

## Cons:

- Administratively burdensome for providers

# *Recommendation:*

## *Option 1 - Credential via CAQH*

- Lightest start-up lift
- Most cost-effective centralized credentialing option
