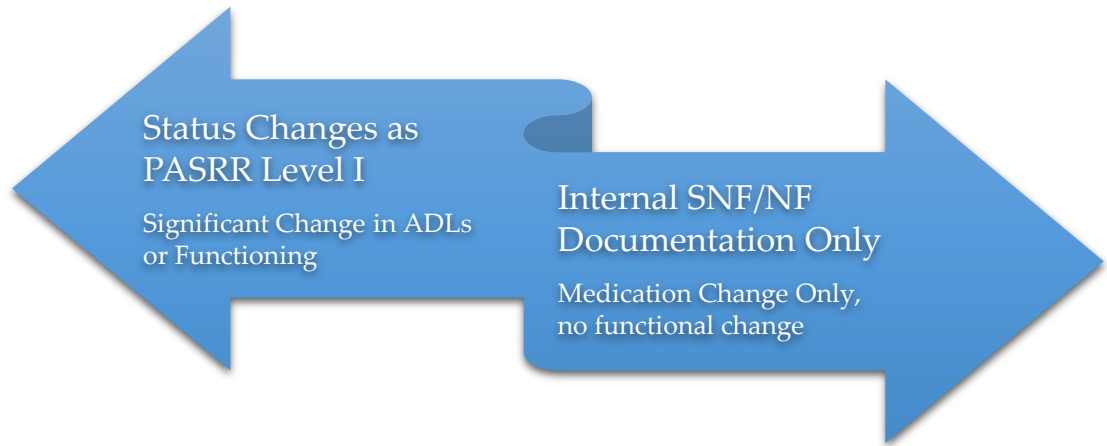


When to Request a PASRR Status Change



There has been a shift so that previous PAL triggers that were “PASRR reportable” that are not considered a true PASRR status change per CO’s definition, “any significant change in the residents’ condition”, **do NOT** need to be submitted to Telligen as new PASRR Level I Screens. See crosswalk below.

Old Trigger on PAL	Telligen PASRR Level I Screen Required
Admitted without PAS Level I	Yes
PAS Level I missing a mental health diagnosis	Yes, if potential PASRR Condition
PAS Level I missing psychiatric meds for a mental health diagnosis	Yes, if potential PASRR Condition
Increase in psychiatric/behavioral symptoms, not due to dementia	Yes
Readmission to NF after IP psych stay	Yes
New mental health diagnosis	Yes, if potential PASRR Condition
Contradictory mental health diagnoses requiring clarification	Yes, if potential PASRR Condition
New discovery of Intellectual/Developmental Disability	Yes
New or worsened serious symptoms – not due to Dementia or other organic condition	Yes
New category of psychiatric medication started for psychiatric diagnosis only, no other symptoms	No, document in clinical record only
New or increased psychiatric medications for Dementia only, no documented MI in history	No, document in clinical record only
Significant improvement in condition	Yes, if previous Level II evaluation in effect
Expiration of Time-Limited Approval at admission	Yes
Level II no longer representative of client’s current condition	Yes
