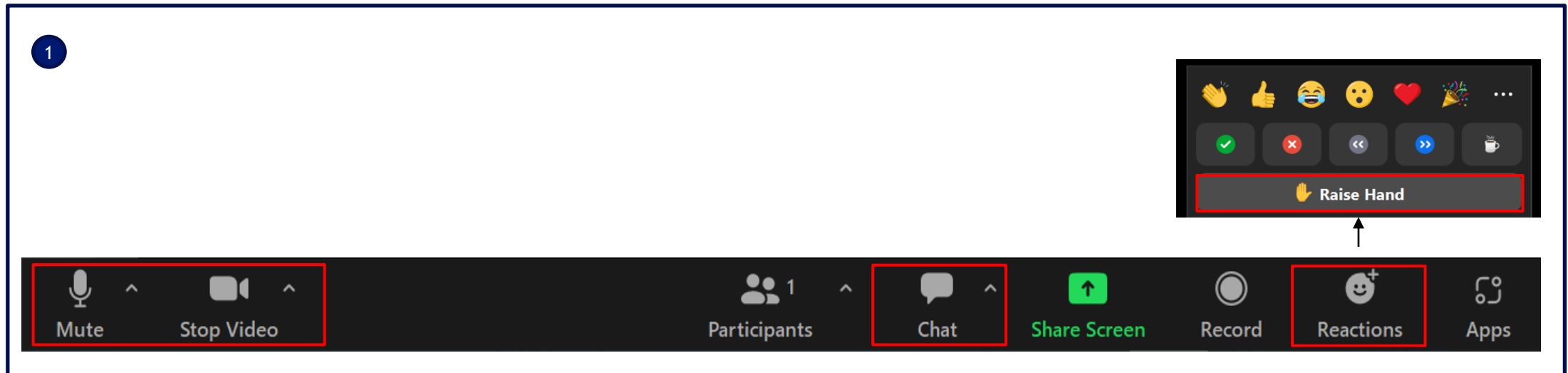

For all value-based programs at HCPF:

“Improving the health, equity, access, affordability, and outcomes for all Coloradans”

For PACK:

“Where every kid with Health First Colorado has the opportunity for a healthy childhood via equitable engagement with a primary care medical provider, which is pediatric prevention-focused and provides access to management of illness and injury.”

The Purpose of the Design Review Team (DRT)

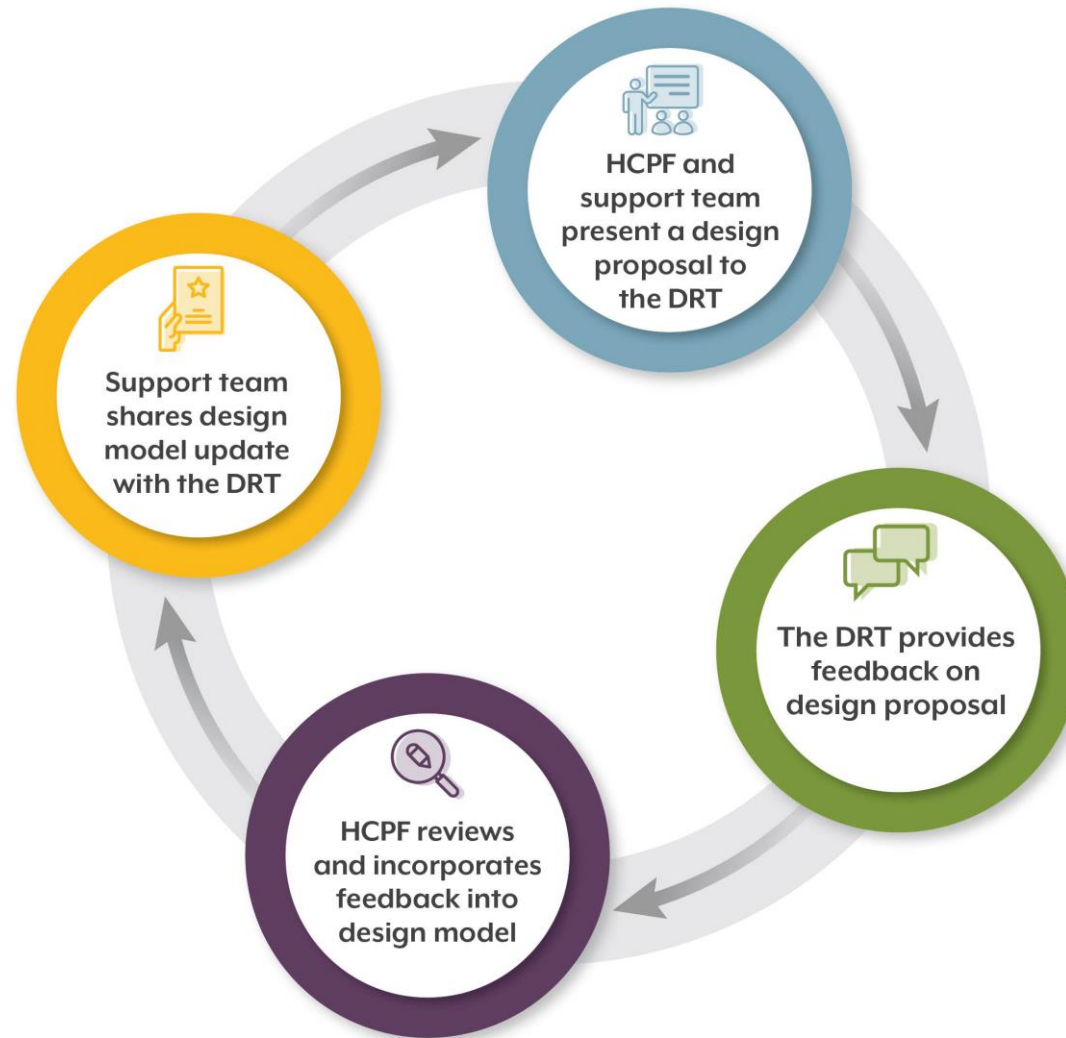
To inform the design of the Payment Alternatives for Colorado Kids (PACK) program.

In Scope	Out of Scope
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Communicate insights, experience, and expertise on the topics presented• Make suggestions or propose ideas for the design of PACK within the context of the topics presented• Provide feedback to any consideration or option put forward for the design of PACK• Ask questions!	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make final decisions on the design of the PACK program• Provide formal recommendations (i.e., report or standard documentation)

The Design Review Team will provide iterative feedback to HCPF on key design topics

1. **Goals and Objectives:** What are we trying to achieve?
2. **Quality Measurement and Quality Target Setting:** How will performance be measured and rewarded to align with program goals?
3. **Payment:** What adjustments to payment are needed to adequately support high-value care delivery? What is the mechanism of how providers will be paid?
4. **Performance Improvement:** What information do providers need to be successful?
5. **Program Sustainability:** What types of support will be needed to sustain this program?

4. What is Value-Based Payment?

What is Value-Based Payment?

- Value-based payment models reward providers based on **achievement of quality goals** and, in some cases, cost savings.
 - These are **in contrast** to traditional fee-for-service payment models, which are based on the volume of care.

The current APM 1 and 2 programs focus on primary care



The goals of APM 1 and 2 are to introduce **accountability** for outcomes, provide **stable revenue** for participants, allow for increased investment in care improvement, and reward savings in **chronic conditions care management**.



APM 1 Primary Care Medical Provider (PCMP) participants receive adjustable fee-for-service payments based on **defined quality measure** performance.



APM 2 PCMP participants can receive a **flexible PMPM** (per-member per-month) payment as well as a shared savings incentive payment dependent upon **savings for members with defined chronic conditions**.

But a pediatric-specific APM is needed

1. Health care is different for kids: focused on providing **preventive services** more than treating chronic conditions.
2. Preventive services drive **outcomes (and savings) over decades**, not days.
3. Health First Colorado serves 40-50% of Colorado's kids; the **health of future generations** starts here.
4. Our shared mission: **Keep Colorado's kids healthy.**
