Dear Pediatric Behavioral Provider,

Participation is appreciated for all those who attended the Pediatric Behavioral Therapy (PBT) rate discussion held December 15, 2022.

The comments and proposals have been reviewed and considered. The rate process is set in regulation and a multitude of factors must be considered, including (but not limited to):

- regulatory compliance
- clinical standards and best practices
- access to care
- federal and state authority
- budgetary authority

Recommendations must be approved by the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (the Department), the Office of State Planning and Budget (OSPB), the Joint Budget Committee (JBC) and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

Access to care within the pediatric behavioral therapy benefit is a high priority. The rates team will take all comments and begin an off-schedule review. That review is anticipated to take place by mid-January. This review does not guarantee immediate rate changes will take place. However, this rate review will inform of any action taken by the Department to address concerns.
