Care Coordination - September 2025

- MCEs began submitting "MCE Data Element Files" in Phase III
 - MCE generated reports on various topics
- Focused on Care Coordination Engagement and Outreach data at PAD meeting
- Discovered and addressed numerous data integrity concerns
 - Ie. Different definitions for values, blank fields, incorrect provider ID formats etc.
 - Plans are resubmitting all data on 12/15/25 with updates and changes
- Began broad and simple analysis of data presented in first month submission
