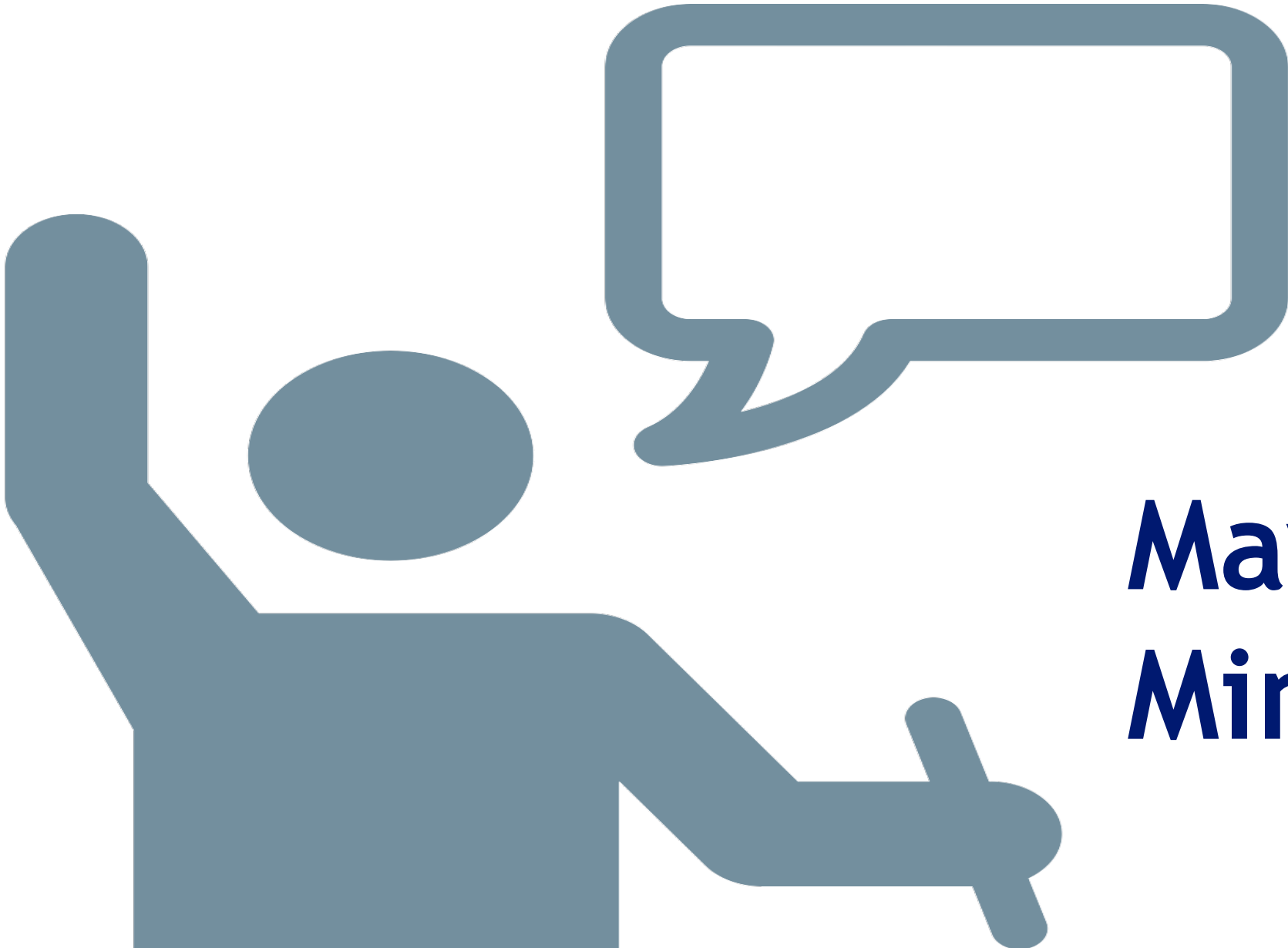

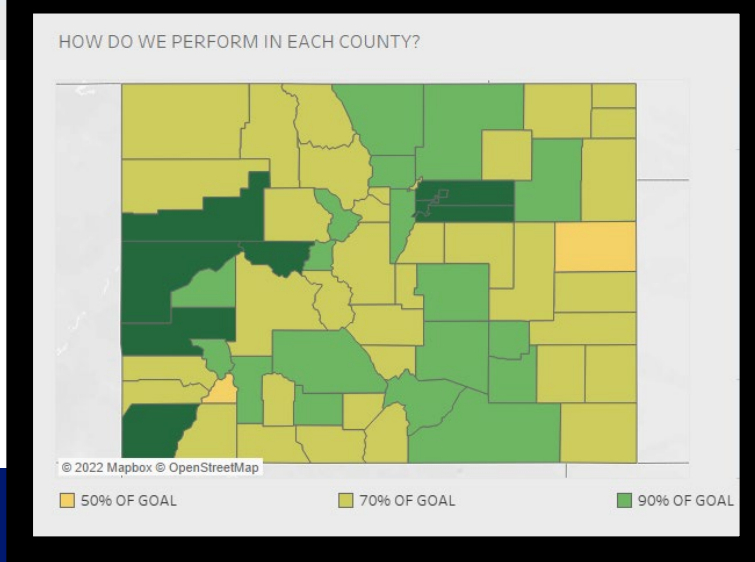
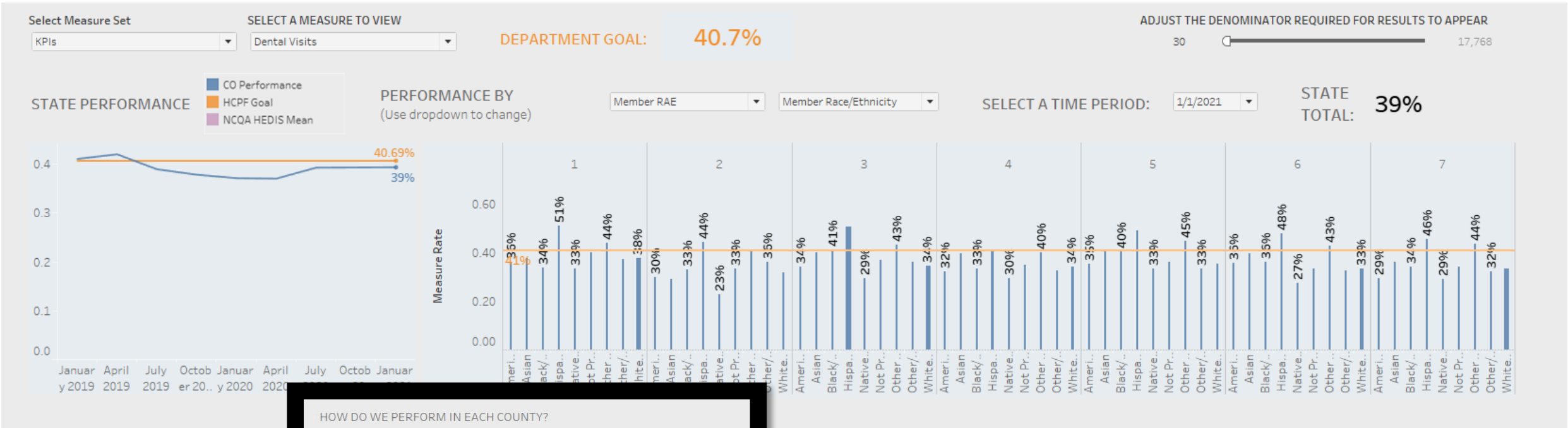
# Well Child Visits

- Committee recommendations vote
  - ❖ Improve education for Members on Well Child Visits
  - ❖ Other top recommendations
    - ❖ Increase efforts to address transportation issues for Members coming in for their Well Child visits.
    - ❖ RAEs to encourage practices to use their extended office hours to include well child visits in addition to sick visits.
    - ❖ RAEs to partner with schools, school districts, and school-based clinics (where available) to increase access to well child visits and to educate on the availability and importance/value of well child visits.
    - ❖ Implement a State requirement for a well child visit at age-appropriate intervals

  - ❖ Summarize committee findings, recommendations, and share with the PIAC.

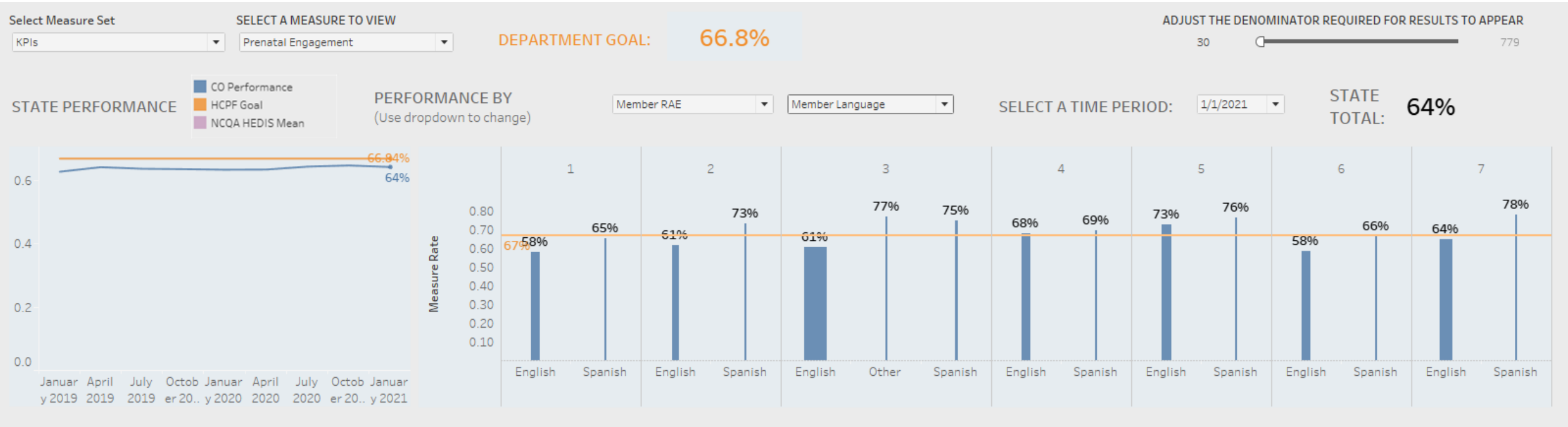

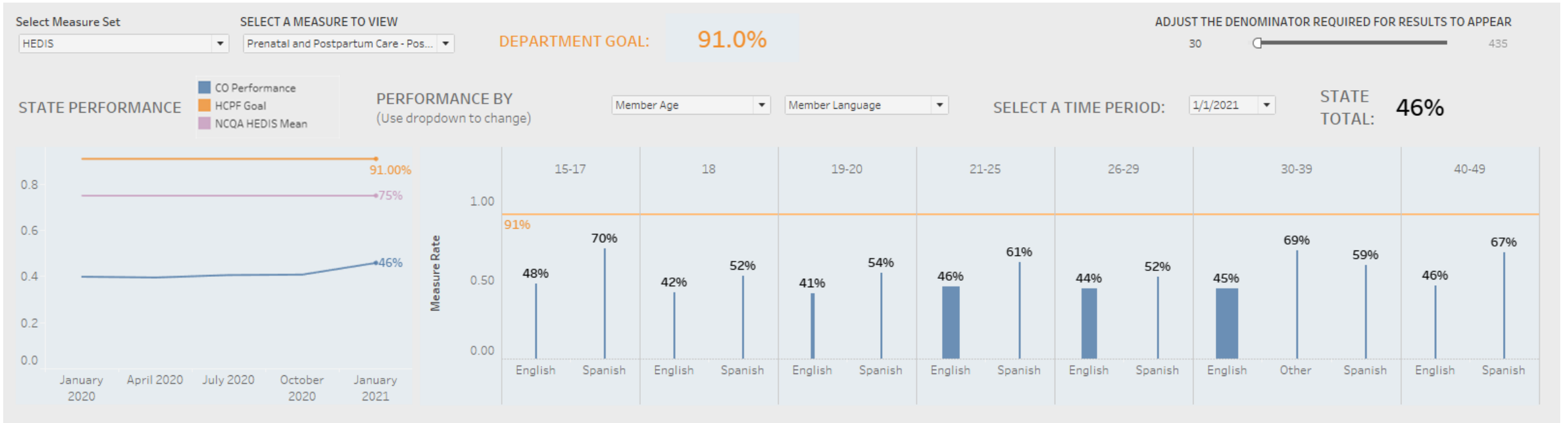

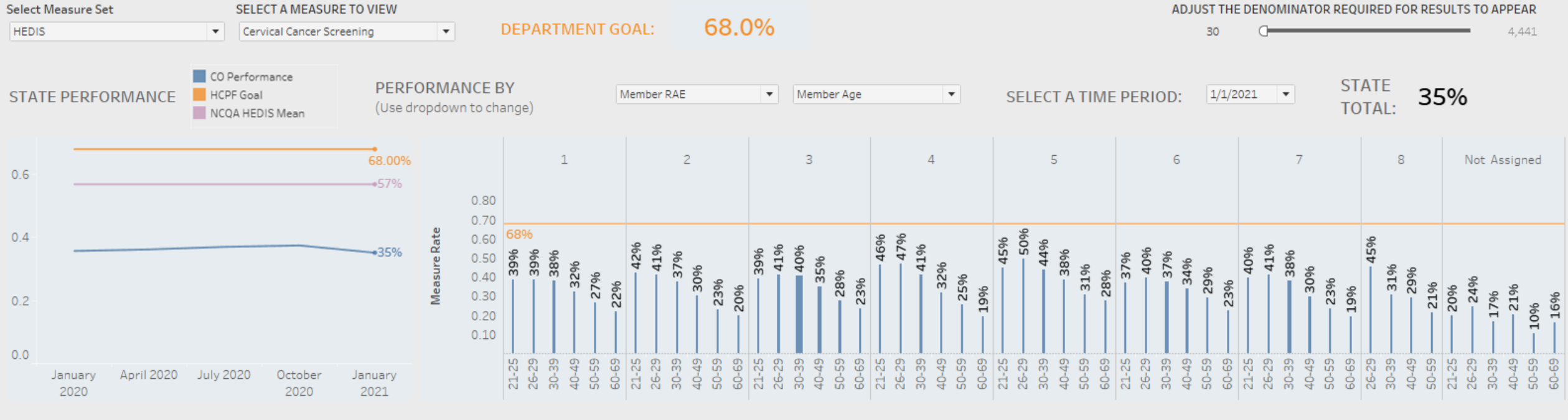

- Potentially Replacing Dental Engagement KPI with **Oral Evaluation, Dental Services**(CMS Core Measure NQF 2517)
