- Public Health Emergency Unwind - Public Health Emergency has been extended for another 90 days
- Workforce Discussion Updates
- Region 6/7 (Colorado Community Health Alliance) MEAC update
  - Community Incentive Program (CIP) - distributes funds from KPI incentive program as grants to community organizations who serve Health First CO members



# January PIAC (cont.)

HCPF Presentation on COVID-19 vaccination efforts - Health First Colorado member specific COVID-19 vaccination data available on ACC Public Reporting website

- 47.1% of members are fully or partially vaccinated (vs. 75.1% of Colorado population)
- 16.9% of 5-11 yr olds fully or partially vaccinated
- 48.8% Hispanic/Latino
- Low uptake among English speakers (vs. Spanish vs. Other)
- Wendy Nading (Tri-County Health Dept.) discussed partnership with CO Access and how the data were used for successful neighborhood level vaccination efforts. Importance of having a trusted clinical partner involved.
