Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits

Percentage of children ages 3 to 21 who had at least one comprehensive well-care visit with a primary care practitioner (PCP) or an obstetrician/gynecologist (OB/GYN) during the measurement year.

Denominator: Ages 3 to 21 as of December 31 of the measurement year.

Numerator: One or more well-care visits during the measurement year. The well-care visit must occur with a PCP or an OB/GYN, but the practitioner does not have to be the practitioner assigned to the child.

HCPF Goal: 80%

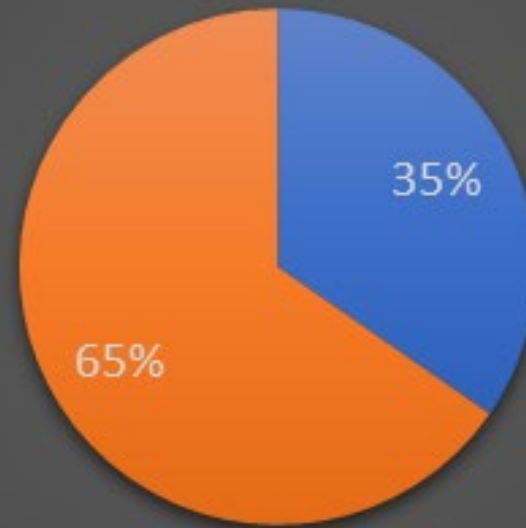

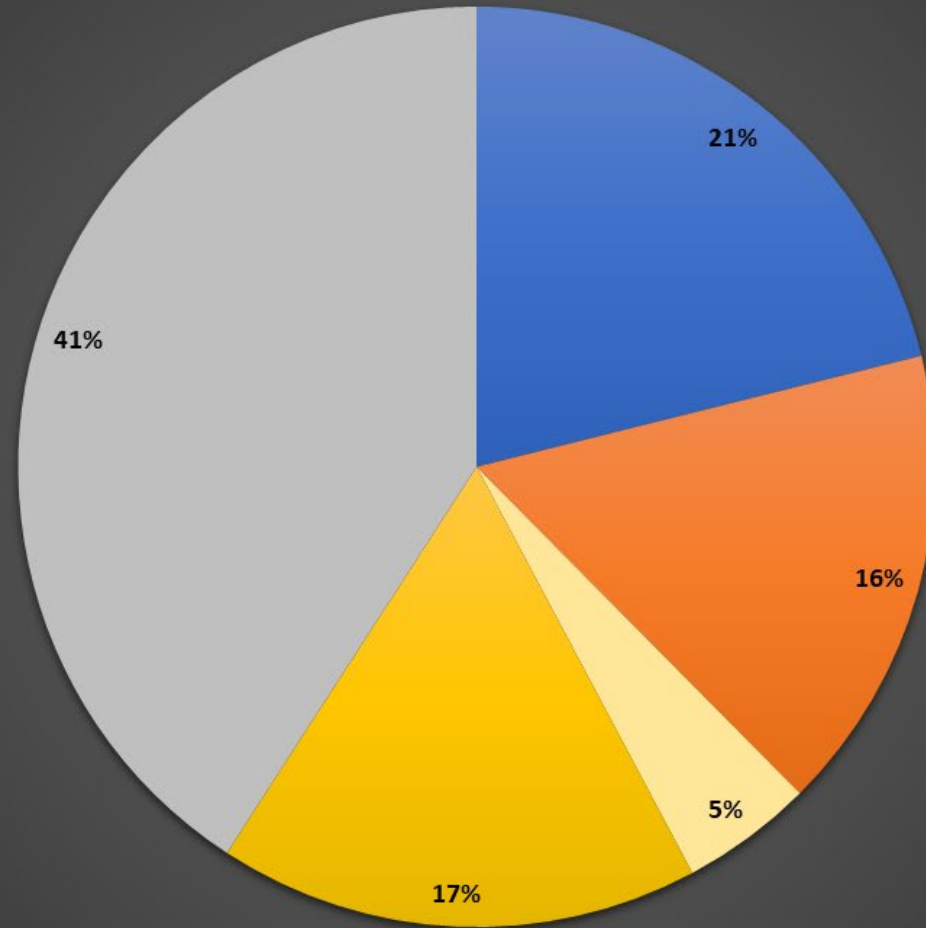

■ Eligible Members who had a Well Visit

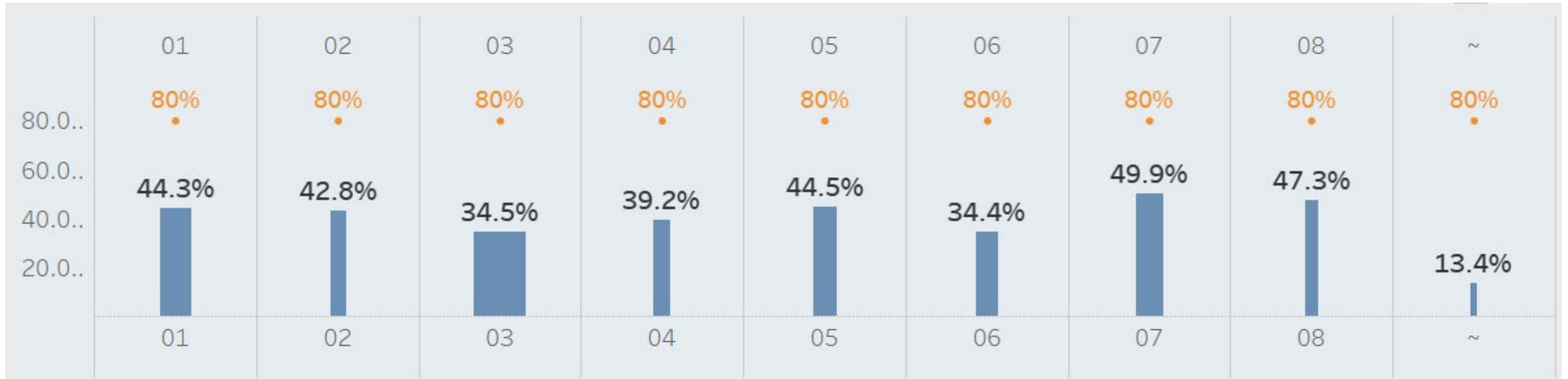
■ Eligible Members who did not have a Well Visit

FY 20-21 Care Received by Members 3-21 without a Well Visit

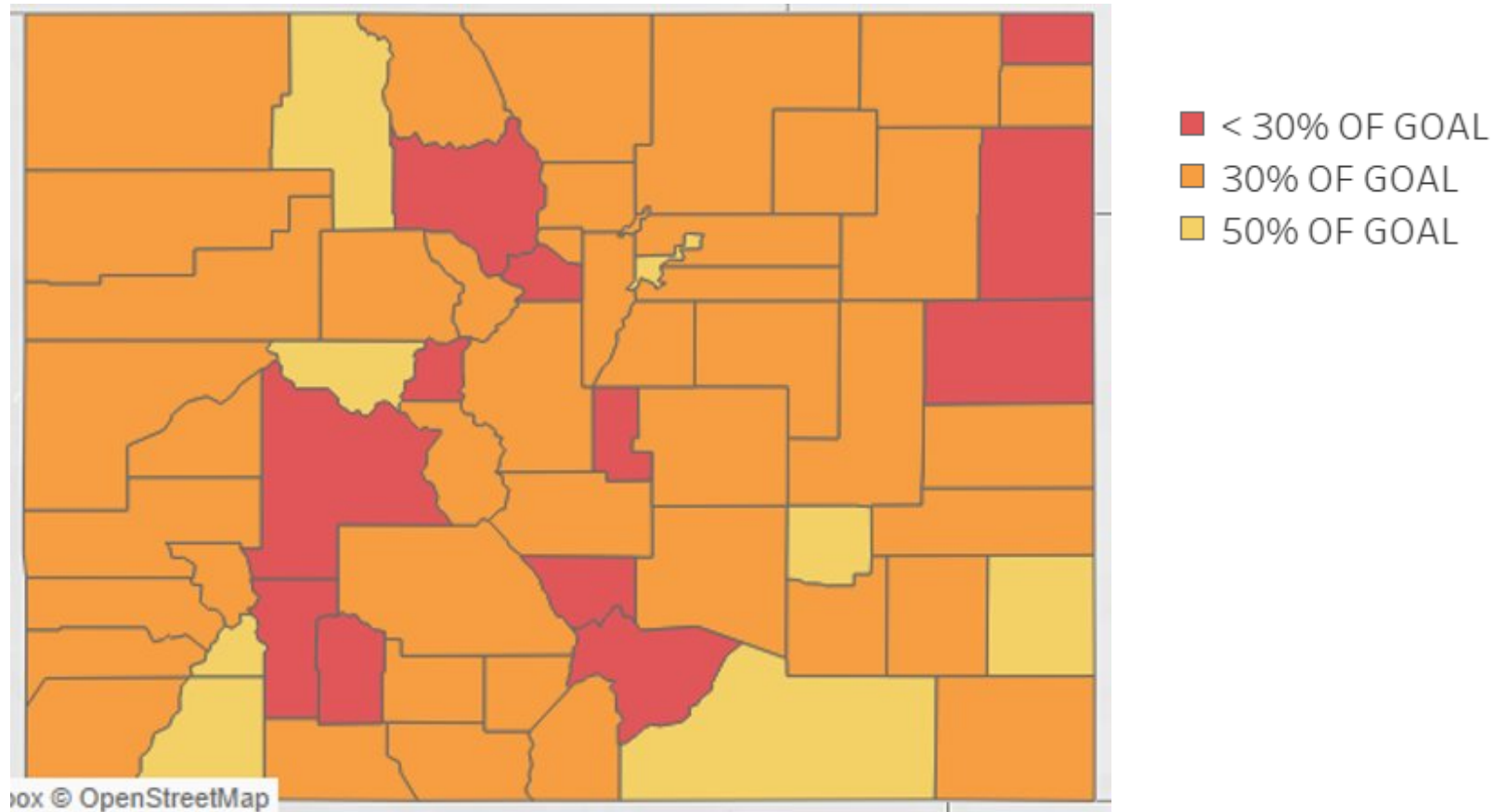

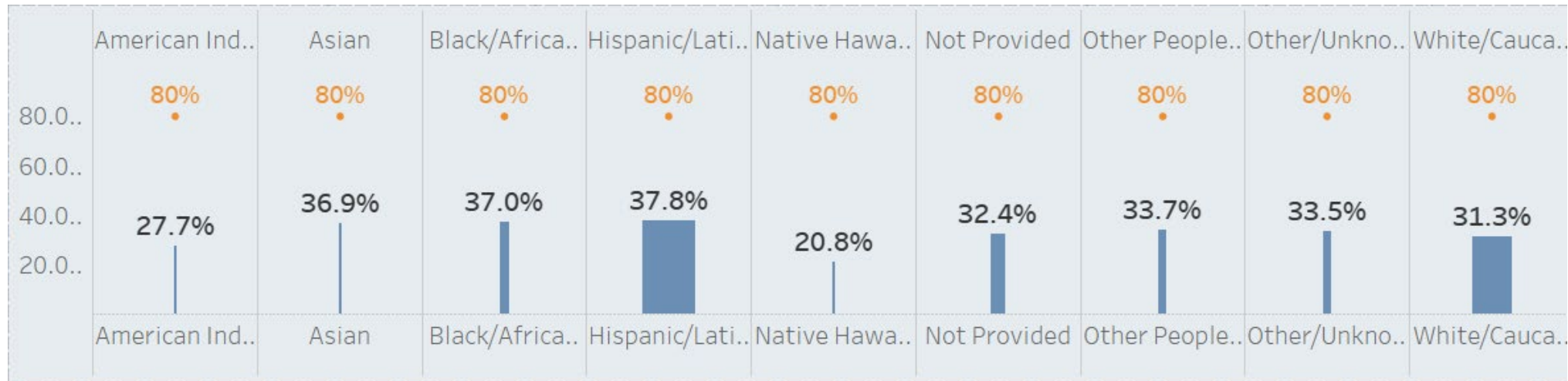
Performance by Region



Well Visit Performance Varies by County

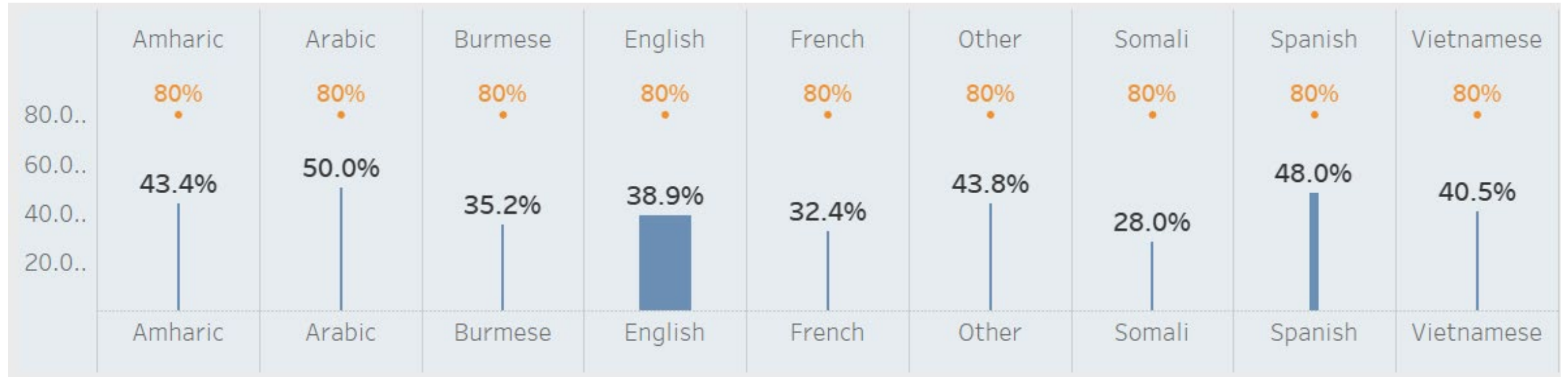


Performance by Race / Ethnicity Categories

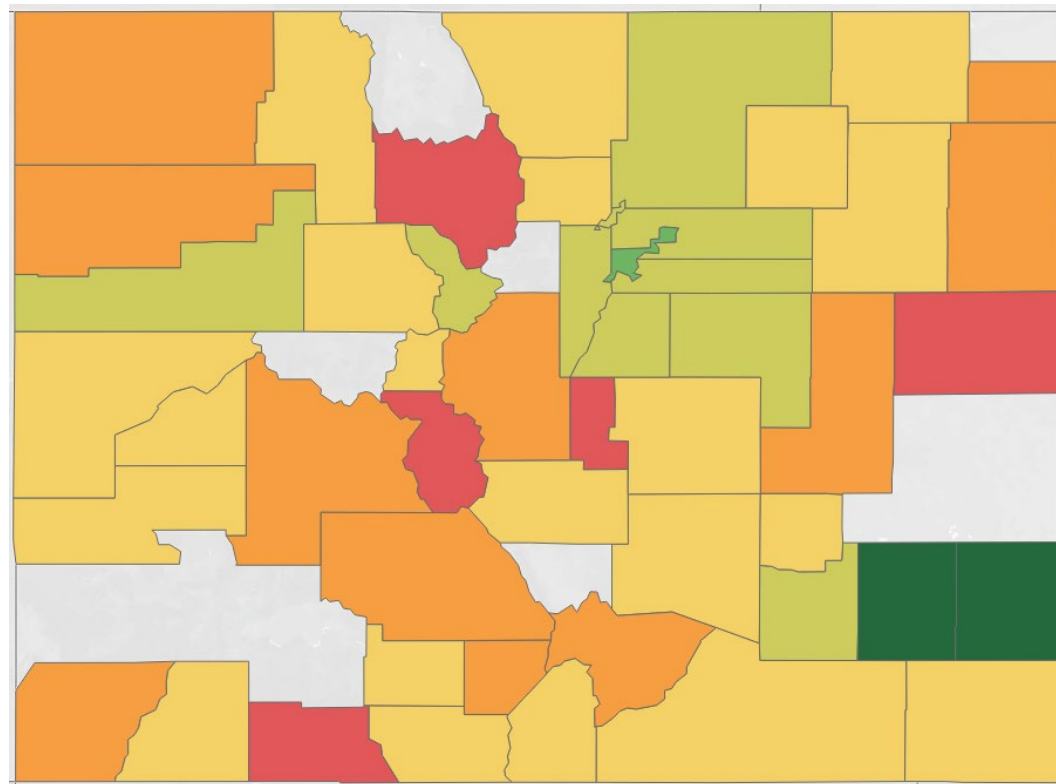


- National Median- 79.2%
