

# Are you pregnant? Or, did you recently give birth?

**If you have Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program) coverage you could be eligible for extended coverage the first year after giving birth.**

You need to tell Health First Colorado that you are pregnant or recently gave birth, so you get health coverage for 12 months after you had a baby. You can do this in the way that works for you:

- **Visit [Colorado.gov/PEAK](https://Colorado.gov/PEAK).** If you don't have a PEAK account, you can create one at [Colorado.gov/PEAK](https://Colorado.gov/PEAK).
- **Use the Health First Colorado app on your phone.** This free app is for Health First Colorado and Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+) members.
- **CHP+ members can call 800-359-1991 (State Relay: 711).** Help is available in multiple languages.
- **Contact** your county department of human services.
