



Are you pregnant? Or, did you recently give birth?

If you have Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program) coverage you could be eligible for extended coverage the first year after giving birth.

You need to tell Health First Colorado that you are pregnant or recently gave birth, so you get health coverage for 12 months after you had a baby. You can do this in the way that works for you:

- Visit Colorado.gov/PEAK. If you don't have a PEAK account, you can create one at Colorado.gov/PEAK.
- Use the Health First Colorado app on your phone. This free app is for Health First Colorado and Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+) members.
- CHP+ members can call 800-359-1991 (State Relay: 711). Help is available in multiple languages.
- Contact your county department of human services.
