CONCERNING EXPANDING THE DEFINITION OF "ELECTRONIC MONITORING SERVICES" TO INCLUDE REMOTE SUPPORTS FOR THE HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES WAIVER FOR THE ELDERLY, BLIND, AND DISABLED.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-6-303, amend (9) as follows:


**25.5-6-303. Definitions.** As used in this part 3, unless the context otherwise requires:


(9) "Electronic monitoring services" means electronic equipment or adaptations OR OTHER REMOTE SUPPORTS that are related to an eligible


person's physical impairment DISABILITY and enable the person to remain at home.

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.


