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Did You Know?

End of Grace Period for OPR Providers

The grace period on claims payment for Ordering, Prescribing and Referring (OPR) Providers has ended; claims for the following provider types will deny if the referring provider is not actively enrolled with Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program).

- Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, and Supplies (DMEPOS)
- Home Health and Private Duty Nursing
- Pediatric Personal Care
- Radiology and Imaging services
- Laboratory services
- Physical, Occupational, and Speech Therapy services (outpatient)
- Audiology services
- School Health Services Program (physical, occupational, and speech therapy services)

Reminder: Self Service Provider Web Portal Registration Available

The Password Reset Webform is an easy self-service method to request a password reset for access to the [Provider Web Portal](#). The Password Reset Webform is only available for account administrators who have previously registered for the Provider Web Portal. Registration must be completed ahead of using the Password Reset Webform.

Providers may register by visiting the Provider Web Portal home page and entering the information related to the provider ID. Portal Registration is a required step for administrators, and may be completed on behalf of providers who have an approved enrollment application.

The account administrator is solely responsible for creating delegate accounts but is not responsible for resetting delegate passwords in the Provider Web Portal. Delegates **may not** request an administrative password reset.

Provider profile account Administrators are responsible for creating delegate accounts but are not responsible for resetting delegate passwords in the [Provider Web Portal](#). If a delegate needs to reset a password, the delegate may use the "Forgot Password" function on the Provider Web Portal. The [Provider Services Call Center](#) is not able to reset passwords for account administrators or for delegates.
