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SHS Program Overview

Any public school district or Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES) with students in kindergarten through twelfth grade may participate

Medicaid reimbursement received for health services already being provided

Jointly administered with Colorado Department of Education (CDE) Reimbursement goes to school district or BOCES to be used on health needs

SHS Program Overview Services Provided

Must be listed on an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or other medical plan of care





SHS Program Overview Cost Based Reimbursement



School Health Services (SHS) Program	School Based Health Clinics (SBHCs)
Services that are medically necessary for the student to receive an education	Services that the student would receive at a doctor's office or clinic
Funded by certified public expenditures (CPEs) with federal matching dollars	Funded by grants, donations, Medicaid, CHP+, and private insurance
Health services listed on the student's IEP or other medical plan of care	Do not provide services listed on an IEP
Program administered by HCPF and CDE	Follows standards set forth by Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment (CDPHE)

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can a Private Duty Nurse bill Medicaid for services provided in a school setting?

A: After receiving authorization by the school district, health service providers may bill Medicaid directly for services provided in a school setting. Other important requirements of this type of arrangement are outlined in this letter.

Q: Are telehealth services billable through the SHS program?

A: Yes, in fact they are a valuable method of delivery for rural

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Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do all school districts participate in the program?

A: No, however school districts who do participate include 87% of the student population. Districts/BOCES who would like to participate should email

Q: Can a private school participate in the SHS program?

A: No, only public schools may participate.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can charter schools participate in the SHS program?

A: Charter schools are public schools and may participate under their public school contract or through the Charter School Institute.

Q: Can participating school districts be reimbursed for outreach and enrollment activities?

A: Yes, this is part of quarterly Medicaid Administrative Claiming cost reporting.
