Scope of Work

WHAT:

AKA "Cover All Coloradans" bill

- 1. Population Expansions: regardless of immigration status
 - Pregnant people
 - Postpartum people (up to 12 months)
 - Children age 18 and younger
- 2. Lactation Service Expansion: (breast pumps + counseling)
 - Breast pumps COMPLETE
 - Federal approval COMPLETE
 - New Hire: Lactation Support Services Policy Specialist, Jessica Werner
- **3. Waiver to Cost Share EMS with DOI:** to make subsidized insurance plans for undocumented Coloradans more affordable
 - Concept paper in development
 - Working with federal partners and working on options
- **4. Health Services Initiatives (HSI) funds:** to improve the health of Medicaid and CHP+ children



Population Expansions

WHAT:

Buildout by January 1, 2025

WHO:

- Pregnant People
- Postpartum People (12 mos)
- Children <19

CURRENT WORK:

- Maximize federal match through different authorities
- Community Ambassador Program (CAP)
- Toolkit and Social Media Packet
- Stakeholder Engagement (Monthly Meetings, 09/04 next meeting)



Lactation Expansion

WHO:

- All Medicaid and CHP+ Members
- 28 weeks -> Postpartum Period

WHAT:

- Expanded access
 - Single user electric (6/8/22)
 - Multi-user (1/1/23)
- Comprehensive Lactation Counseling Services COMING
 - SPA Approved
 - Switching focus to member engagement VS. provider
 - Decision tree

CURRENT WORK:

- Members may acquire a breast pump from Health First Colorado or WIC
- Outreach on Breast Pumps
- Over 9,000 single-user electric breast pumps distributed (June 2022+)
 - Previous year: 105

Stakeholder Engagement

CURRENT AND PAST WORK:

- Held Monthly Stakeholder Engagement meetings
 - February 2024 June 2024
- Community Ambassador Program
 - 10 organizations, state wide, funded from February July 2024
 - Held focus groups, tabling/information sessions
- HCPF Newsletter Updates

FUTURE WORK:

- Re-start of CAP (more sites, more funding)
 - Enrollment Sessions in Late Winter and Early Spring
- Re-start Monthly Stakeholder Meetings (09/04/2024)
- Enrollment Webinar (Date TBD)
- Coverage Go-Live: January 1, 2025
