Background and Goals

Overall Goals for the Department's Capacity Work

1. Develop understanding of Colorado's capacity for substance use disorder (SUD) treatment at all levels
2. Identify gaps in the availability of services

Examples:

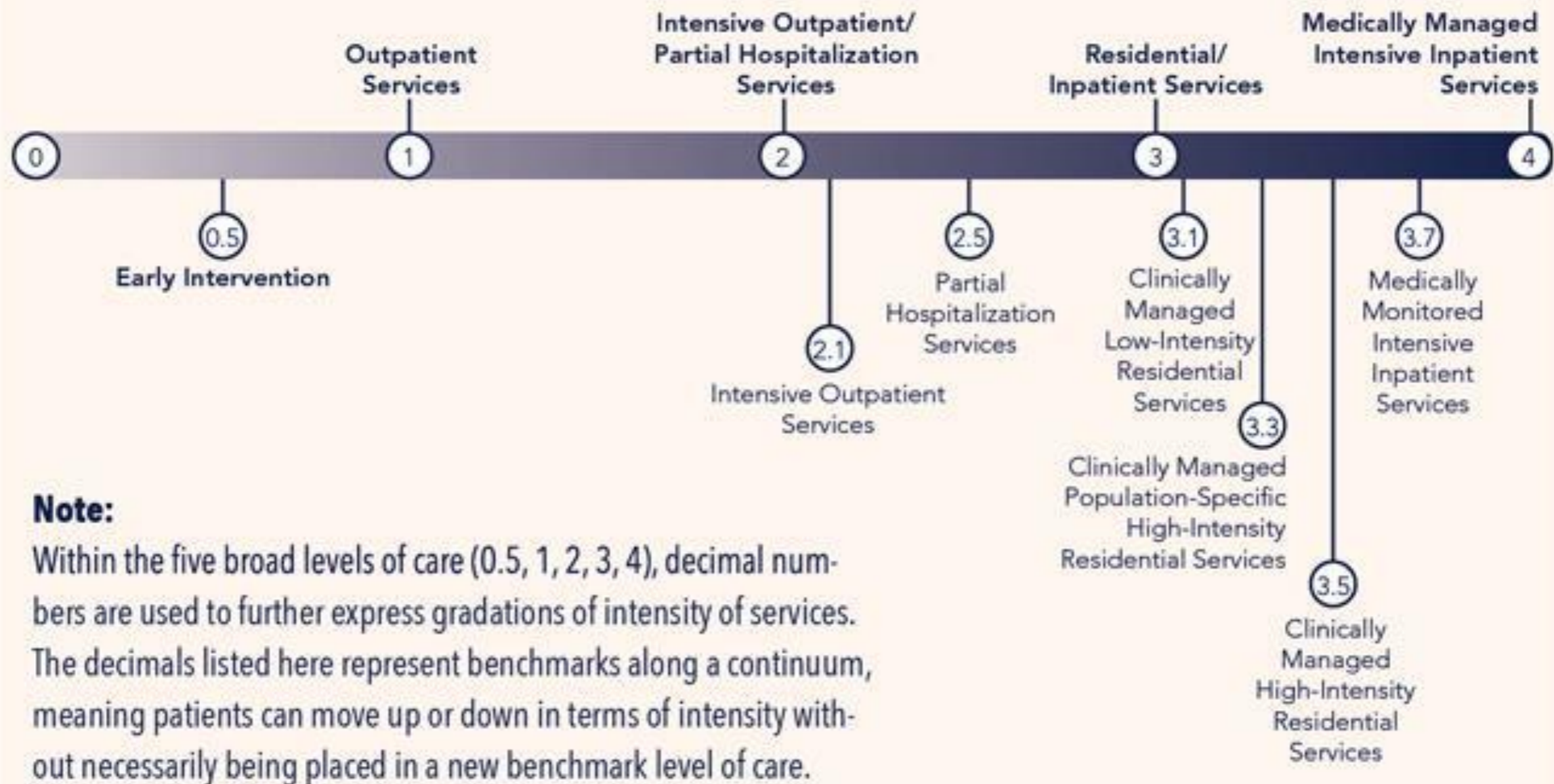
- Shortages in the number of beds available compared with the demand for treatment
- Levels of care where no treatment is available in parts of the state
- Populations that have limited access to critical SUD services

Capacity Goals (Continued)

3. Develop a plan for addressing capacity deficiencies
4. Support the Regional Accountable Entities (RAEs) in developing SUD provider networks in anticipation of expanded SUD service coverage by Medicaid

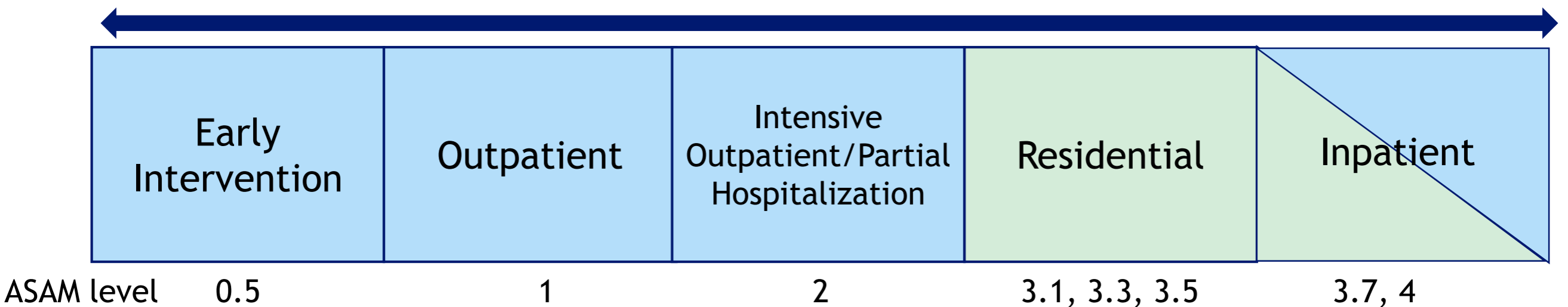

REFLECTING A CONTINUUM OF CARE

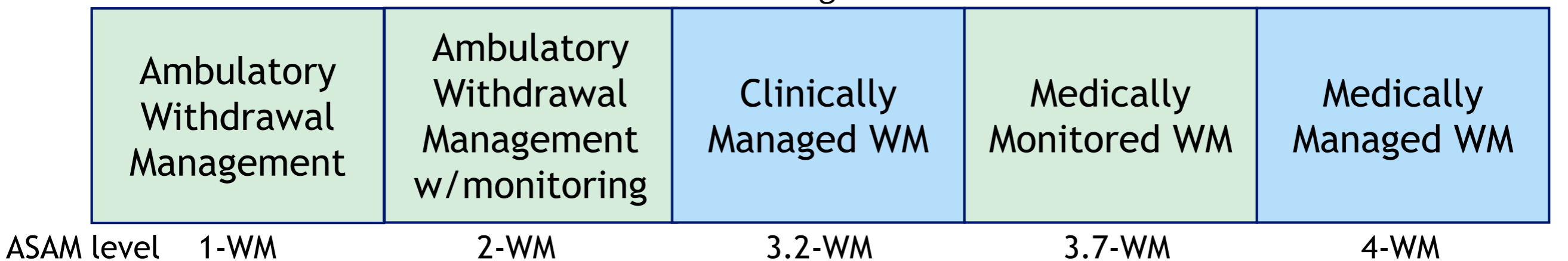


Medicaid Coverage of SUD Services in Colorado

- Collect additional information about regional needs from stakeholders

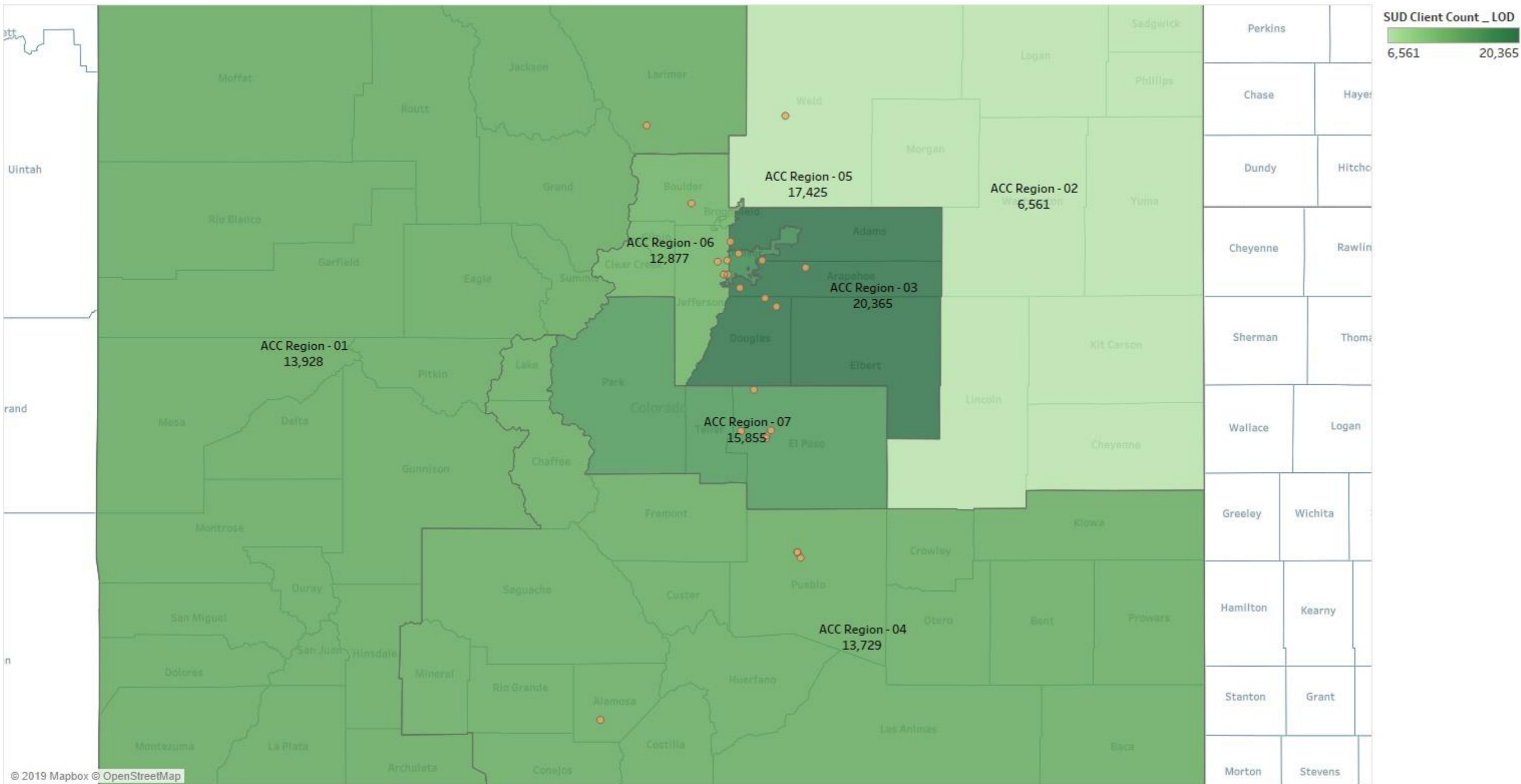
Data Mapping

SUD Diagnosis Density

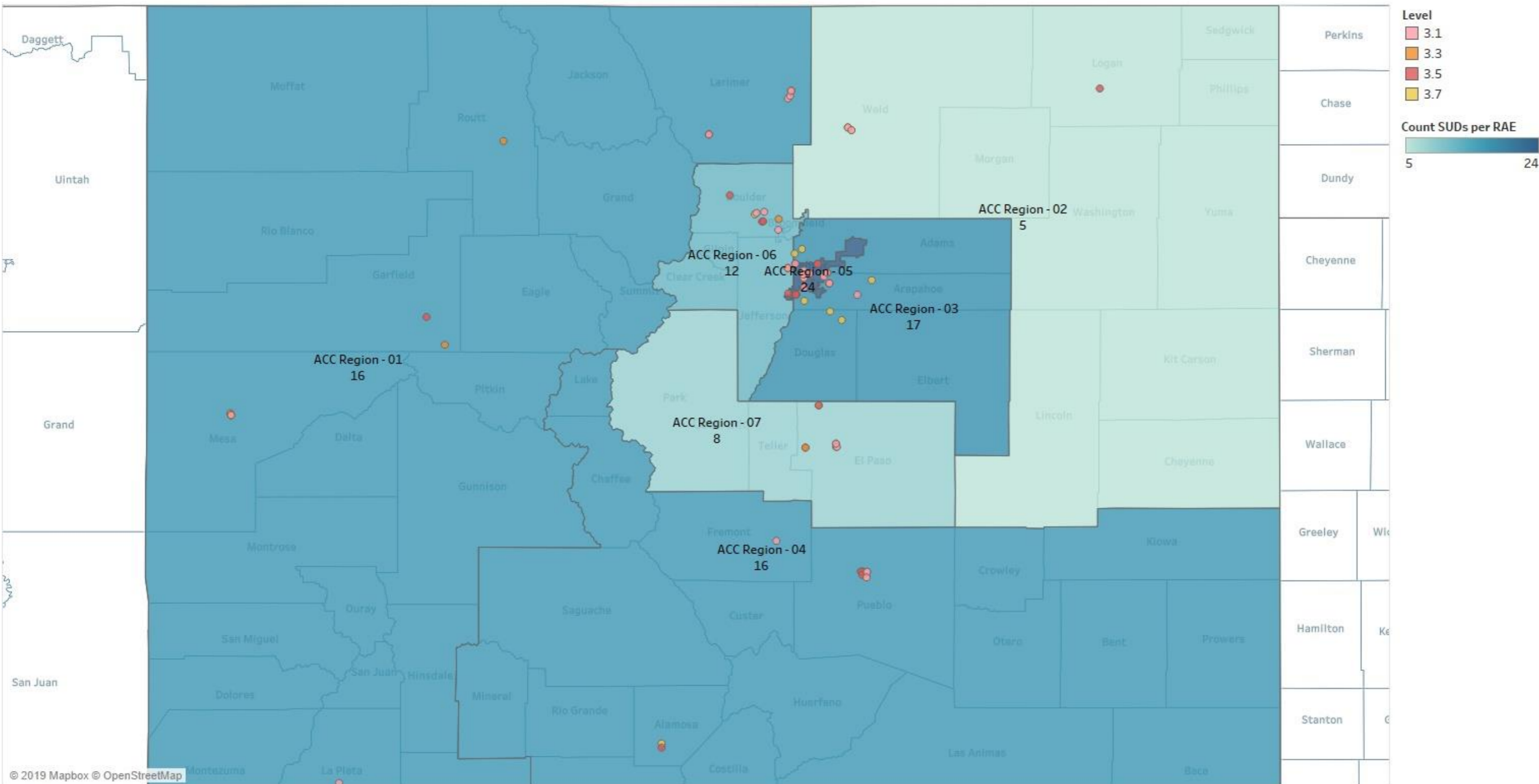
SUD DX Client Population by RAE Region

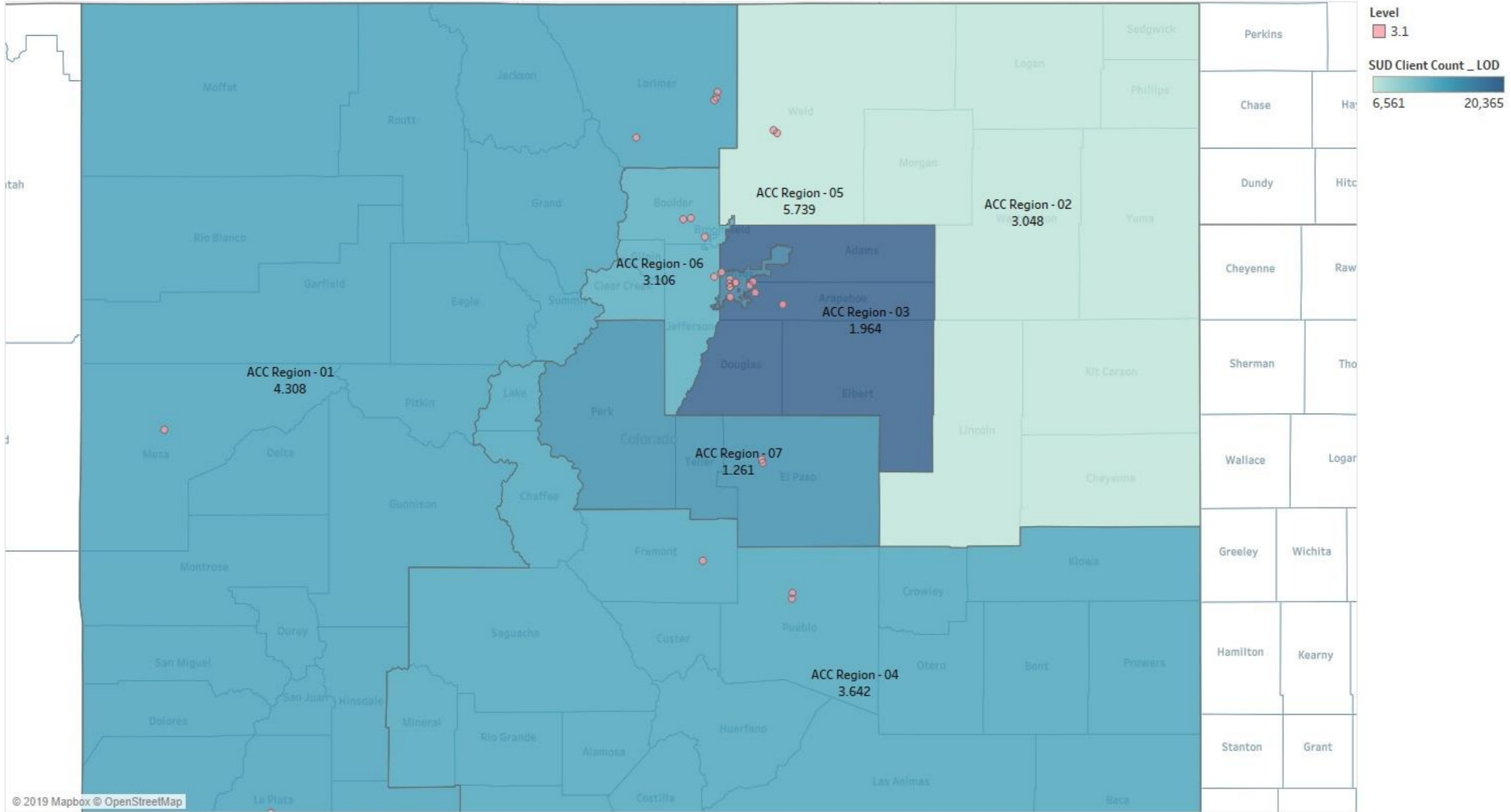
All ASAM Level 3 Providers per RAE

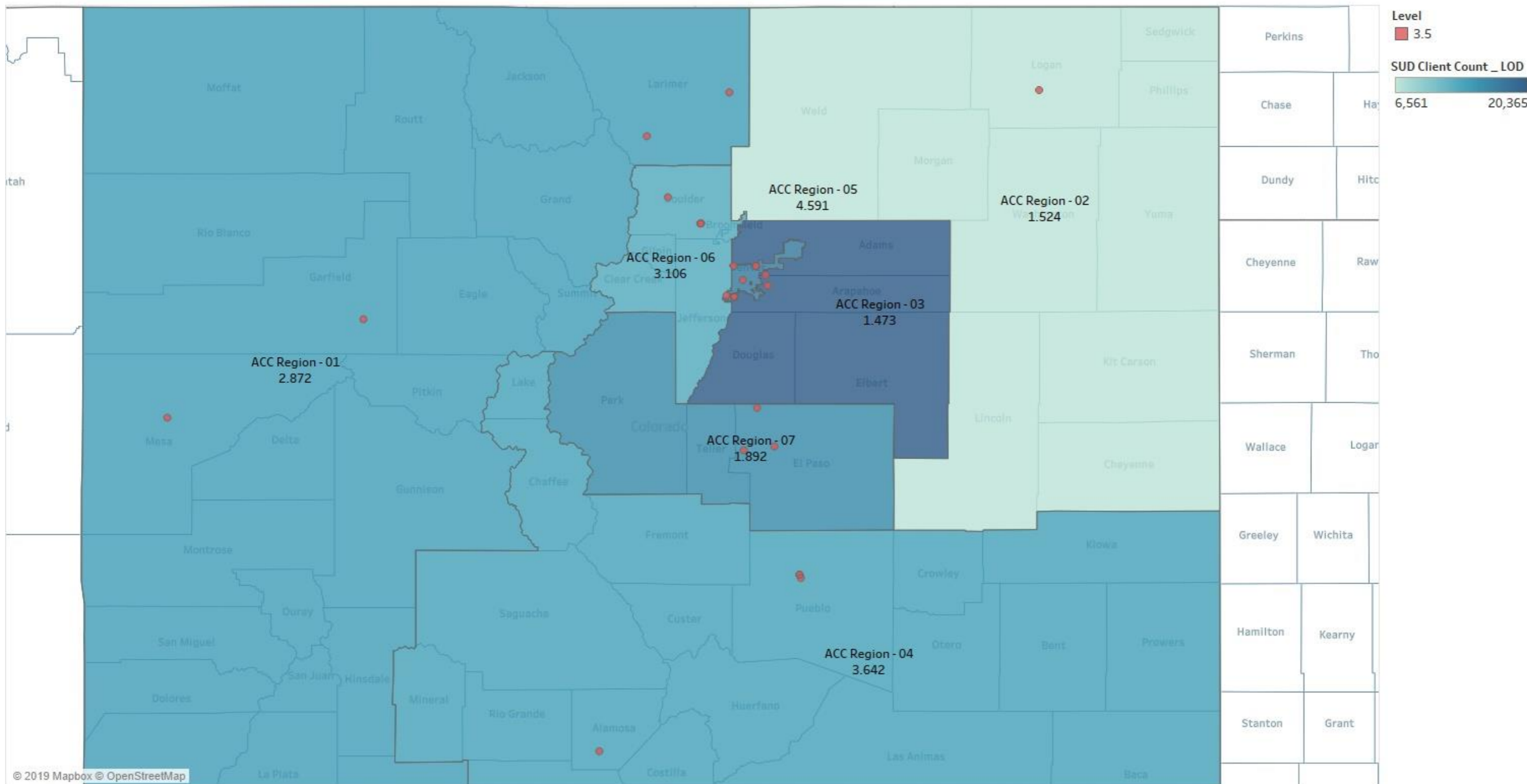
ASAM Level 3.1 Providers per 10,000 SUD DX Members

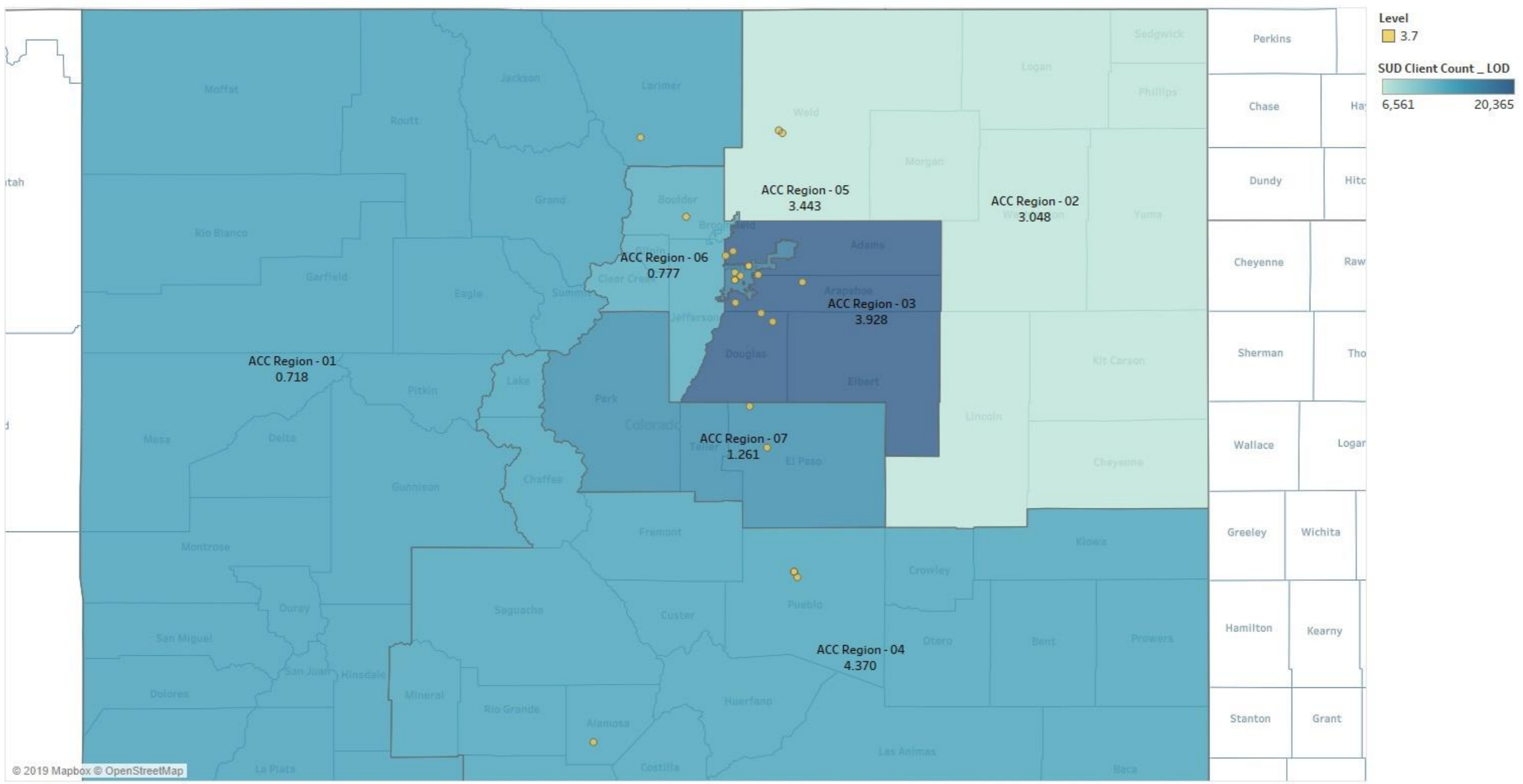
ASAM Level 3.5 Providers per 10,000 SUD DX Members
