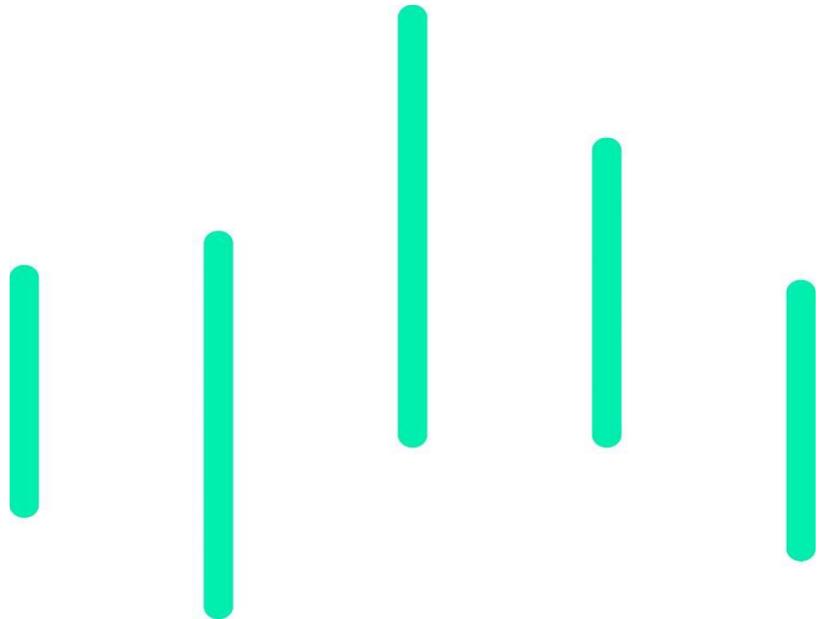

# Introduction

This document is intended for software vendors who wish to develop applications that interact with Colorado Medical Assistance Program SFTP file delivery and retrieval system. It was created and is maintained by Gainwell Technologies for the purpose of uploading and downloading Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) compliant transactions.

Trading Partners cannot receive Health Care Claim Payment/Advice (835) transactions without selecting the transaction type(s) and signing the Trading Partner Agreement in the Enrollment Application. Refer to the [Getting Started Guide](#) for more information.

## Interface Standards

Colorado Medical Assistance Program file delivery and retrieval system interfaces support two of the most used channels of communication, HTTP/S (web) and Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP), giving clients a variety of interfaces to develop robust interchange solutions.

## Web interface

---

The web interface is comprised of one independent HTTP/S application interface that support batch ASC X12 transactions. A diagram of the interaction flow is below.

## Secure website

The website is an interface that allows users to upload and download files to and from the batch file repository. Once logged in, users can upload batch files to the secure server for processing. To upload batch files, navigate to the ToHPE folder, and launch the upload/download wizard. To retrieve batch response files, navigate to the FromHPE folder, and click the download link next to each file displayed.

Complete user interface documentation can be found by clicking on the “Help” link found in the menu in the middle of the home screen. A screenshot of the website is provided below.

**Note: Batch ASC X12 files must be uploaded one at a time. Users cannot use the zip option within the upload/download wizard.**



# SFTP interface

---

The SFTP interface supports batch file uploads and downloads only. Users may use SFTP (SSH) clients such as Filezilla, Putty, and WS\_FTP Pro to transfer files or develop software that will logon and transfer files programmatically using SSH protocol. Complete specifications can be found in the [“SFTP \(FTP over SSH\) Specifications”](#) section of this document.



# SFTP (FTP over SSH) Specification

This section covers the most frequently used SFTP commands. An SFTP connection can be established using [mft.gainwelltechnologies.com](http://mft.gainwelltechnologies.com).

**Note:** Users are required to change passwords on first login.

When logging in through SSH/SFTP on port 22, you must prefix your username as follows:

colorado-fts-np\username for non-prod  
colorado-fts\username for prod

## Uploading files

---

To upload files via SFTP, navigate to the ToHPE directory and upload the file following your specific SFTP software instructions.

## Downloading files

---

To download files via SFTP, navigate to the FromHPE directory and retrieve the respective file, following your specific SFTP software instructions.

# Security Standards and Practices

In order for Gainwell Technologies to guarantee a safe and stable working environment, the following security standards and practices have been established. These measures protect users and Gainwell Technologies from potential threats.

## Password creation requirements

---

Passwords must contain:

- A minimum of 8 alpha-numeric-special characters
- At least 1 upper and 1 lower case alpha character
- At least 1 number
- At least 1 special character Passwords **cannot**:
  - Be similar to username (TPID)
  - Use any common 'dictionary' words
  - Use previous six (6) passwords
