

Statewide Net Reimbursement





Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) related school closures and online learning environment lead to increase in MAC percentages


Four Year MAC RMTS Percentage Trends by Quarter

- Identify all district users by access level
- Assess if roles or access needs to be updated

- Contact PCG with requests for changes
- Email requests to add or remove access to PCG
