SUD Utilization Management Report	 The <u>SUD Utilization Management DY3 Annual Report</u> is posted on the HCPF SUD website. This report shows utilization trends for SUD residential and inpatient services across the first three years of the 1115 Demonstration (2021 - 2023). Coverage for PHP Services (ASAM 2.5)	 As of July 1, 2024, Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program) now covers ASAM 2.5 Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP) services. Providers interested in delivering this level of care are encouraged to reach out to the BHA regarding licensing. Providers already licensed to deliver PHP services are encouraged to reach out to the MCEs regarding contracting. If you have any questions, please reach out to use at hcpf_sudbenefits@state.co.us
New Specialty Types under PT 64	 As of July 1, 2024, new Specialty Types have been added under PT 64 to align with BHA Endorsements. See pg 215 of the July 2024 <u>SBHS Coding Manual</u> This primarily affects outpatient providers. Instead of enrolling as Specialty Type (ST) 477 regardless of license, your enrollment with Medicaid will align with your BHA endorsement (just like how it is in the inpatient space). Providers do not need to re-enroll because the PT is not changing. Rather, outpatient providers must submit a maintenance request through Gainwell to modify your ST. HCPF expects providers to update their Specialty Type(s) before the end of the calendar year which is when ST 477 will be retired.

Data Gathering for SUD 1115 Interim Evaluation Report	This portion of the call was facilitated by Mercer - HCPF's 1115 contractor, and their independent evaluator - TriWest, to gather data for the SUD 1115 Interim Evaluation Report.
	The Interim Evaluation Report assesses how effective the demonstration's initiatives have been in producing the desired outcomes for beneficiaries with substance use disorder that are also Medicaid beneficiaries.

If so, what specific pieces of the Demonstration have impacted your acceptance of new Medicaid patients?
