Services (procedure codes) that Peer Support Professionals can provide for Medicaid Members per the State Behavioral Health Services (SBHS) Billing Manual

Peer Support Professionals can deliver many services that are reimbursable by Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program). Peers can work in a variety of settings and offer support in any area where a member with a behavioral health diagnosis is receiving care from a Health First Colorado provider. As an addition to the member's care team, they can offer practical solutions and focused problem solving to help members practice building skills needed to maintain their health and wellbeing. Below are examples of the broad range of services Peers may deliver.
