Operational Memo 20-083

Specialized Habilitation (SH)

- > Provided by current SH provider agency only
- > Can include virtual or in-person group activities
- > IRSS Settings can be provided 1:1, in the home
- > GRSS Settings visitor restrictions

Supported Community Connections (SCC)

- Temporary allows for community to be accessed virtually through previous SCC provider only
- > Temporary allows IRSS or GRSS PASA to provide SCC services to member's who reside in the home
 - SCC must be provided apart from residence

Proposed 3-Tiered Approach to Specialized Habilitation (SH)

Tier 1 - Virtual Only

- > May be provided individually or in groups virtually
- Ideal for members who only need minimal in-person support, do not want to risk exposure, or prefer virtual services
- Anticipated lower reimbursement rate

Tier 2 - Current Service Delivery

- Services provided similar to pre-pandemic SH
- Providers may serve members at a base site or out in the community in groups
- > Reimbursement rate would remain at the current rate

Proposed 3-Tiered Approach to SH, cont.

Tier 3 - Individual

- Ideal for members who cannot receive services in a group or virtually, or members who need 1:1 support
- > Reimbursement rate would be higher than current rate
- Weekly cap for number of hours of Tier 3

Feedback on 3-Tiered Approach to SH

- What issues or obstacles do you see for providers?
- What impact would this have on the quality of service provided?

Other IDD Day Program Services

- Supported Community Connections
 - > Could a similar 3-tiered approach work for SCC?
 - Such as virtual, current practice, and individual
- Community Connector
 - > Already an individual service
 - > Is there a benefit to allowing this service to be provided virtually long-term?
- Other ideas or suggestions?
