may be able to provide the help
you need







If you have an **urgent need for support services** for an intellectual or developmental disability and you're **unable to get services though other programs**, you may still be able to get limited services through the **State-SLS Program**.

How do I get these services?

You may qualify for the State-SLS Program if you:

- Are 18 or older and you have an intellectual or developmental disability
- Are unable to access other resources, such as Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program), and Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) waiver programs.

To apply:

Contact your local Case Management Agency (CMA)

A Case Management Agency helps you see if this program is right for you and helps you find services.



State Supported Living Services (State-SLS) Program

If you have an intellectual or developmental disability, this program provides supportive services to help you live in your home or community.

Services Categories

You may be eligible to receive services if you fall into one of these categories. Each category has a distinct set of services and service limitations.

- Waiting for HCBS waiver enrollment provides access to services during the enrollment process for the SLS Waiver * (which is different than the State-SLS Program)
- Experiencing temporary hardship provides temporary, limited assistance, such as: utility payments, emergency food and pest infestation abatement
- Need support to remain independent in the community provides one-time payment to purchase equipment and supplies for a new living arrangement, such as: furniture, pantry set-up, kitchen supplies and housing application fees
- Ineligible for the HCBS SLS Waiver State-SLS can provides limited access to some of the same services *
 - * Examples of some services you may qualify for:
 - Behavioral Services
 - Day Habilitation
 Services (Specialized Habilitation,
 Supported Community Connections)
- HCBS Dental Services
- Personal Care Services
- Respite Services
- Specialized Medical Equipment and Supplies
- Vision Services

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
