In November the consortium hosted a Black Action Committee community roundtable event to explore engaging leaders in the African American Community to address the disproportionate rate of overdose deaths. A committee is being established to explore the needs of the African American Community further and information will be provided through the Consortium as available.

Intensive Outpatient Services (IOP) are allowable without pre-authorization to members as part of the continuum of care treatment options for members who have a Substance Use Disorder diagnosis? For more information see Code H0015, page 78 in the <u>Uniform</u> <u>Coding and Services Manual</u>. Pre-authorization may be required; see the RAE page for the member you are treating to determine.
