



Dear Trading Partners and Vendors,

The **Production** Colorado Medicaid SFTP (Secure File Transfer Protocol) server available at <https://colorado-fts.xco.dcs-usps.com> (IP Address = 206.164.88.55) is anticipated to be decommissioned on Wednesday, November 9, at 7:00 p.m. Mountain Time. The current system will be replaced with a new SFTP link and related IP addresses.

For HTTPS users, current username, password, folder structure, and files will automatically migrate to a new SFTP server at <https://mft.gainwelltechnologies.com/colorado-fts>. Connectivity to this server will begin on the same day after decommissioning has completed.

SSH/SFTP users accessing SFTP on Port 22 must enter "colorado-fts\" before the username for access to the new server. This would look like: colorado-fts\username. Other than this change, the password, folder structure, and files will automatically migrate to the new sever. Connectivity to this server will begin on the same day after decommissioning has completed.

Prepare Ahead

To prepare for the file transfer system service move, the following information may be shared with the appropriate technical contact at your organization as needed.

SSH/SFTP: mft.gainwelltechnologies.com Port: 22

If your organization requires network firewall configuration to allow outbound connections:
