



Social Security Number and Date of Birth Verification Form

Individuals who apply to public housing agencies for rental housing assistance must include verification of social security number (SSN) and date of birth per Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) PIH 2012-10 (HA) issued February 14, 2012. Residents of nursing facilities and/or institutions may not have access to birth certificates, social security cards or other standard forms of identification that would provide this information.

HUD Notice PIH 2012-10 (HA) states that the public housing agency can accept an original document issued by a federal, state, or local government agency, which contains the name and SSN and date of birth of the individual as acceptable evidence.

This document is issued by the Colorado Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) to verify the following individual's SSN:
