



Dear Provider,

Some laboratory and radiology claims for procedure codes with rates subject to the Clinical Diagnostic Laboratory Upper Payment Limit (CDL UPL) that processed on or after January 1, 2020, were overpaid.

The Department received approval on January 7, 2020, for a State Plan Amendment (SPA) submitted under transmittal number [\(TN\) 19-0028](#) regarding Laboratory and Radiology Services. This amendment decreases [Clinical Diagnostic Laboratory \(CDL\) rates](#) on a per test basis to align with Medicare rates in accordance with the [Social Security Act Section 1903\(1\)\(7\) Upper Payment Limit](#) (Refer to the article "Clinical Diagnostic Laboratory Upper Payment Limit Rates" in the [January 2020 Special Provider Bulletin B2000443](#)).

Affected claims will be reprocessed by DXC Technology (DXC) and funds recouped in the coming weeks. This will begin to appear on remittance advices on Monday, July 6. More information will be provided in future communications.
