- The Department is continually working to improve member correspondence
- A member's understanding of the VCL can affect their eligibility
- Most of our members receive the VCL at least once during the application or redetermination process





COLORADO

How

- CBMS users surveyed to identify problematic VCL items for special attention during the rewrite process

 These items were chosen for consumer testing scenarios
- The Colorado Department of Human Services and Connect for Health Colorado were instrumental in the VCL rewrite and involved in the entire process
- Stakeholders provided feedback on 2 different VCL Drafts
- English and Spanish drafts consumer tested with diverse participants
- The Department's Member Experience Advisory Council provided feedback and that is reflected in the final product



COLORADO

No Policy Changes

Only changing the way the letter looks and reads

- Same amount of time to provide requested information
- Same info being requested
- Program Areas listed in same order





COLORADO

New Verification Checklist

- Written in plain language that is understandable to members
- Shortened, non-redundant introduction
- Alternate shading (grey/white) to better separate each VCL item
- Increased white space for improved readability
- Order of information presented within the VCL
