Overview of Survey

- Each participant ranked at a minimum 5 options.
- Ranked by priority of what participants would like to focus on first
- Topics/Choices derived from stakeholders via feedback from the parking lot and during our brainstorming session on next steps from the November 5th meeting

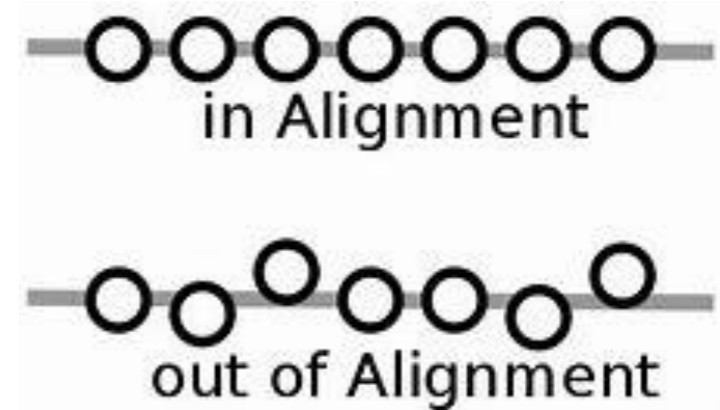

This idea and wording was brought up by cochair Bob Lawhead during our November 5th stakeholder brainstorming session on next steps.



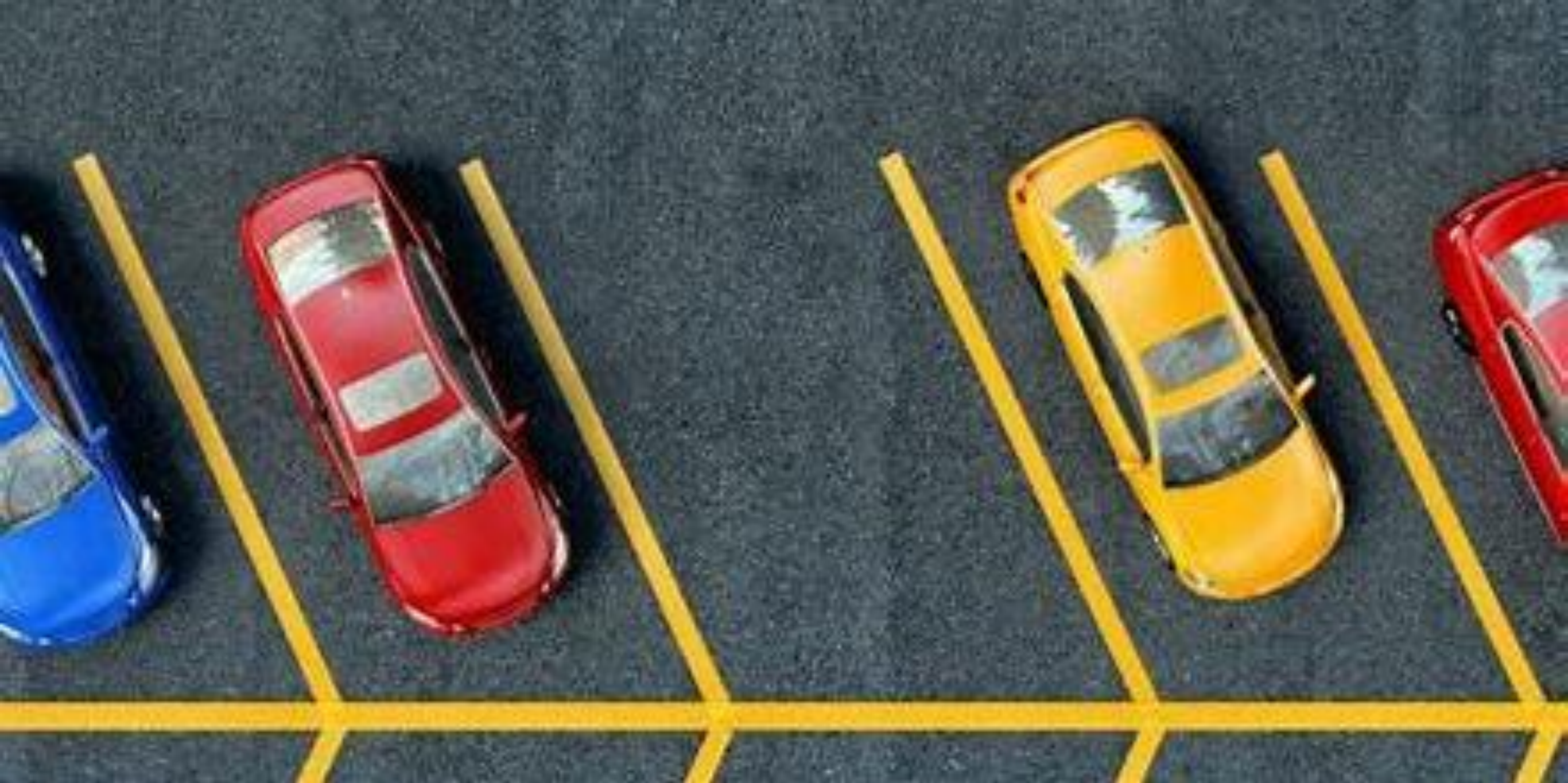
